Peace Be With You

When the churches reopened for Liturgical celebrations, we, the clergy, often got the question, "When are we going to give the sign of peace?" Maybe to some of us, we felt the Mass was incomplete without sharing the "sign" of peace before receiving Holy Communion. We have observed in the past months that, even without the priest saying, "let us offer each other the sign of peace," the congregation still offered peace to everyone while the priest was doing the fraction of the Most Precious Body of Christ. Let's explore the roots and meaning of this gesture:

"The spiritual symbolism of the act is found in the Gospel of Matthew, where Jesus said, 'If you are offering your gift at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.' (Matthew 5:23-24)

"The early Christian community took to heart the instructions of Jesus and incorporated the action into their celebrations of the Eucharist. In fact, the Apostolic Constitutions, a 4th century document, instructs that after the Prayer of the Faithful, "let the bishop salute the church, and say, 'the peace of God be with you all.' And let the people answer, 'and with your spirit'; and let the deacon say to all, 'salute one another with the holy kiss.'"

"The kiss of peace was typically given only to those standing next to each other, and it was later developed that the kiss of peace descended from the sanctuary and was passed on to the people, symbolizing that peace comes from Christ. This was even

further cemented when the priest would first kiss the Altar and then pass on that kiss to his attendants."

However, in the 2005 Synod of Bishops, there was a discussion about the appropriateness of greater restraint in this gesture. The Synod expressed concerns about the abuses of the sign of peace. The list includes singing a song of peace, people moving around the church to exchange peace, priests leaving the altar to give peace to the people in the pews or replacing the word "peace" with condolences at funerals or congratulations on other occasions. These become a moment of distraction and a disruption of the solemnity and sanctity of the Mass, especially when we are in the Real Presence of Christ at the Altar.

One should know that the exchange of peace comes after the consecration because it refers to "the Paschal kiss of the risen Christ present on the altar." It is not a personal greeting to each other. *(From the circular letter of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Sacraments on the ritual expression of the gift of peace at Mass)*

The guidelines from the Holy See also states that, "If it is foreseen that it will not take place properly due to specific circumstances or if it is not considered pedagogically wise to carry it out on certain occasions, **it can be omitted**, and **sometimes ought to be omitted**. It is worth recalling that the rubric from the Missal states: 'Then, **if appropriate**, the Deacon or the Priest, **adds**: Let us offer each other the sign of peace.'"

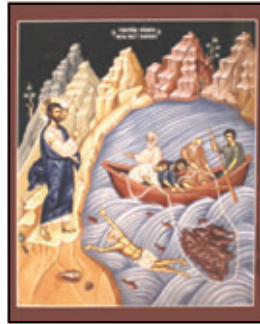

278. "What does Hosanna mean and why do we use it in the Liturgy?"

In St. Matthew's Gospel we read, "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest." (21:9) What exactly does the word "hosanna" mean, and why would the crowd shout it about Jesus at this time?

Hosanna is a transliteration of the Hebrew word "hosi-ah-na," which means to save or rescue, or designates the person who saves or rescues. According to Strong's Concordance, the "-na" suffix is used to express "intense emotion."

While originally the word was originally used as a prayer of intercession asking for God to intervene and save His people -- Psalm 118:25 says, "Lord, grant salvation! Lord, grant good fortune!" -- by Jesus' day, the word had become a shout of jubilation, a statement of praise because God had saved His people. At the Jewish feast of Tabernacles and at Passover, the word continues to be used in this way.

Gradually, this phrase saw its meaning develop as well, acquiring what Pope Benedict XVI in his book "Jesus of Nazareth" described as "messianic significance." "It had become," Pope Benedict writes, "praise of Jesus, a greeting to Him as the one who comes in the name of the Lord, the one awaited and proclaimed by all the promises." So, in shouting "Hosanna" as Jesus entered Jerusalem, the disciples were acknowledging Him as the Messiah, the promised one sent from God to save Israel. We continue to say a variation of this phrase from Matthew every time we participate in the Mass. We pray, "Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest." In so doing, we recognize once again (as the crowd did on that day in Jerusalem) that Jesus is Lord, the promised one of God who comes to save us. Our prayers have been answered. Now, we celebrate God's saving power and love for us.

Bill Targeting Pregnancy Centers Advances



On April 19, the New York State Assembly Health Committee voted to advance A5499/S470, a bill intended to conduct a “study” of pro-life pregnancy centers. The bill would enable the Health Commissioner to subpoena pro-life centers and force them to produce an over-

whelming volume of data and reports. The pre-determined outcome of the “study” is to find the centers “limited” because they do not provide abortion or abortion referrals.

278. “¿Que quiere decir Hosana y porque lo usamos en la Liturgia?”

En el evangelio según San Mateo se lee, “Hosana al hijo de David, bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor, Hosana en las alturas.” (21,9) Que quiere exactamente decir la palabra Hosana y porque la muchedumbre exalta, es acerca de Jesús?

Hosana es una transliteración de la palabra Hebrea Hosi-ah-na que quiere decir salvar o rescatar o designar una persona que salve y rescate de acuerdo a Strong Concordance, el sufijo “na” es usado para expresar una “emoción intensa.”

Mientras originalmente la palabra era utilizada como oración de intersección pidiendo a Dios que intervenga y salve a su gente — el Salmo 118,25 dice, “Señor concédenos la salvación,” Señor concédenos buena fortuna,” por Jesús la palabra se ha convertido en un grito de júbilo en una forma de alabanza, porque Dios ha salvado a su gente. En la fiesta judía de los Tabernáculos y Pascua la palabra continúa usándose de la misma forma.

Gradualmente esta frase ha visto su desarrollo, como también ha adquirido lo que el Papa Benedicto XVI dice en su libro, “Jesús de Nazaret” descrito con “significación mesiánica” el Papa Benedicto escribe, “alaben a Jesús, un saludo para El que viene en el nombre del Señor, el esperado y proclamado por todas las promesas.” Entonces, al exclamar “Hosana” cuando Jesús entro a Jerusalén, los discípulos reconocían en el al Mesías, el esperado, el prometido por Dios para salvar Israel.

Continuamos diciendo una variación de esta frase de Mateo cada vez que participamos en la Santa Misa. 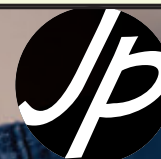

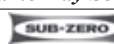
