## HOLY THURSDAY, MARCH 24, 2016 PILGRIM VISIT TO 7 LOCAL CATHOLIC CHURCHES

One of the recommended practices for the Year of Mercy Lent is to "go on a pilgrimage." A Pilgrimage Pamphlet Guide is available at the entrances of the church for those who wish to participate in the venerable custom of "visiting seven churches" on Maundy (Holy) Thursday, March 24, 2016.
