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<p>Jewelry & Hair</p>	<p><u>JEWELRY:</u> -The wearing of jewelry is restricted to watches, small rings and simple chains or pendants (Religious medals may be worn under the uniform) -No Smart Technology pieces may be worn at any time. <u>This includes Apple watches and Gizmo watches</u> -Boys are not permitted to wear earrings -No body piercings</p> <p><u>HAIRSTYLES:</u> -Hair should be kept simple, neat and clean (must be well groomed, evenly trimmed and may not cover the eyes) -Boys hair may not extend below the top of the shirt collar -Dyed hair, shaved heads (partial or whole), any extremes in cut are not permissible</p> <p>The principal reserves the right to determine what is considered an extreme style</p>	<p><u>JEWELRY:</u> -The wearing of jewelry is restricted to watches, small rings and simple chains or pendants (Religious medals may be worn under the uniform) -No Smart Technology pieces may be worn at any time. <u>This includes Apple watches and Gizmo watches</u> -Small post earrings (no hoops or dangling earrings) Limit of 2 per ear -No body piercings</p> <p><u>HAIRSTYLES:</u> -Hair should be kept simple, neat and clean (must be well groomed, evenly trimmed and may not cover the eyes) -Dyed hair, shaved heads (partial or whole), any extremes in cut are not permissible -Hair accessories should be simple, neat and uniform colors</p> <p>The principal reserves the right to determine what is considered an extreme style</p>
<p>Non-Uniform Days</p>	<p><u>“Dress Down Days”</u> are always assigned with the principal’s approval. They permit students to come to school out of uniform. They may be given as a reward to individuals, a class, or the whole student body.</p> <p>-Pants must be worn at the waist -Shorts must be knee length or longer than fingertips -Shirts must not be offensive in nature -NO tank tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops, or cropped tops may be worn at <u>any time</u>. All shirts must have sleeves.</p> <p>If a dress down day falls on a P.E. class day, students should wear clothing that allows them to participate in physical activity.</p> <p><u>“Dress Up Days”</u> are always assigned with the principal’s approval. These days may involve special events, masses, or other school functions in which</p>	

	<p>students are asked to dress in more formal attire. A regular school uniform is acceptable on these days as well.</p> <p>-Students may not wear jeans, shorts, t-shirts, dresses with thin straps, or flip flops</p> <p>-(Girls) Dresses or skirts must be knee length or longer than fingertips</p> <p>-Students may choose to dress up or dress down on the day they are celebrating their birthday (Unless they are attending Mass that morning)</p> <p><u>Spirit Days:</u> On a designated day during the last week of each month we will hold a Spirit Assembly. These days, students are encouraged to wear their class colors with uniform bottoms.</p>
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All children in grades K-5 are required to be in uniform and abide by the dress code every day from the 1st day of school in September to the last day in June. Clothing must “fit appropriately”. Not too tight, not too loose, and/or not too short. The principal reserves the right to determine what is appropriate for dress and grooming. We ask for your cooperation in strictly enforcing these uniform regulations.

Hats & Outerwear

All types of hats, hoods, coats, and non-uniform sweatshirts must be removed upon entrance into St. Lawrence Catholic School. See the Uniform Chart above for acceptable sweater and sweatshirt requirements. Hats and hoods may not be worn before, during, or after the school day at St. Lawrence School.

Uniform Infractions

1. Written Warning. The first uniform infraction will be a written warning that will be sent home, signed by a parent, and returned to school
2. Second Written Warning. The second uniform infraction will be a written warning that will be sent home, signed by a parent, and returned to school
3. Three infractions (or more) will result in an “N” on the report card. Students will sit out of class until the proper uniform arrives at school. A detention or suspension can be issued as a result of a uniform violation after the fourth notice
