### SATURDAY JANUARY 16, 2021

Hebrews 4:12-16 Mark 2:13-17 This selection of Isaiah 55 is sandwiched between chapters that have the common theme of "covenant." In today's reading, all who are thirsty are invited to come and be nourished, to come and be satisfied by God, who invites us again and again into a covenant relationship.

The Responsorial Psalm (taken from a much earlier chapter in the Book of Isaiah) picks up the theme of nourishing water in its refrain, "You will draw water joyfully from the springs of salvation." As a gathered community of faith, we pray these words and celebrate God's faithfulness.

Our Gospel reading for this feast is from the first chapter of Mark. Mark, who unlike Matthew and Luke, does not provide a story of the Nativity, opens his Gospel with what he identifies as a quotation from Isaiah (in actuality, it is a combination of words from two prophetic books, Malachi and Isaiah). In a few short verses, the first six of which we do not hear today, the Gospel writer tells us that the Good News has begun. John the Baptist is introduced and he immediately begins his ministry of preparing the way for Jesus. As Jesus comes up from the water, we hearers of this Gospel, along with Jesus, are told quite clearly that Jesus is the Son of God.

- ◆ God invites each of us to draw near and to be nourished. In a few moments of quiet prayer, express your longing to be nourished.
- ♦ With today's psalm, reflect on the words "God is indeed my savior; I am confident and unafraid."
- ◆ Take some time today to hear God saying to you: "You are my beloved daughter/son; with you I am well pleased."
