Pope to celebrate Mass for Rome's Myanmar Catholics on May 16

Pope Francis will celebrate Holy Mass this month for Myanmar Catholics living in Rome. He will celebrate the Mass at 10.00 am on 16 May, the Solemnity of the Ascension, according to the Prefecture of the Papal Household.

The Pope's gesture for Myanmar comes during the current Marian month of May, during which he has dedicated the Marathon of Prayer, involving Marian shrines across the globe, for an end to the pandemic. On 1 May, the Pope inaugurated the marathon with the first stop in Saint Peter's Basilica. Meanwhile, Cardinal Charles Bo of Myanmar has urged Catholics to pray the rosary and participate in Eucharistic adoration during this month, for peace, justice and human dignity in the country. Speaking on Sunday after the midday Angelus prayer in St. Peter's Square, Pope Francis mentioned the initiative of Myanmar's Church, saying it is very close to his heart. He said it "invites us to pray for peace with a Hail Mary for Myanmar in our daily Rosary". "Each of us turns to our Mother when we are in need or in difficulty," the Pope said. "This month, we ask our Mother of Heaven to speak to the hearts of all leaders in Myanmar so that they may find the courage to walk the path of encounter, reconciliation and peace."

Acts 28:16-20, 30-31 John 21:20-25 The First Reading and the Gospel focus on the betrayal of Judas, which Jesus and Peter describe as a fulfillment of the Scripture. While Jesus is silent on which Scripture is fulfilled, Peter points to Psalm 109:8 ("May another take his office") and Psalm 69:26 ("Make their camp desolate, / with none to dwell in their tents"). For Peter, Judas has done the unimaginable: turned away from the ministry he once received.

In the Gospel, Judas is one of the disciples whom the Father gave to Jesus and whom Jesus guarded, but he is also "lost." How could the Good Shepherd lose one of his sheep? Judas is literally called the "son of destruction" (translated "the one destined to be lost"), a phrase used in 2Thessalonians 2:3, in parallel to "the lawless one," whose coming reveals the working of Satan (2Thessalonians 2:9). Satan had infiltrated the heart of Judas (John 6:70; 13:2, 27). He was not merely lost— he was snatched away!

Jesus' plea to the Father to "keep them [his disciples] from the evil one" thus takes on more urgency. Because Christ prayed for all his future disciples (John 17:20), we know that we too are included in his prayer and likewise receive the gift of the Spirit as described in the Second Reading. This brings us back to the Acts of the Apostles. Choosing an Apostle by lot might seem that the disciples were leaving it to chance. In the first-century Church, however, using lots indicated utter reliance on God's power and the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

- ♦ What might it mean for Christians not to belong to the world but to be sent into the world?
- ♦ How do you see God's love being brought to perfection in you and in the Church?
