#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK . . .

I have been looking over the financial reports for our parish from last year and just wanted to share with you some of my findings. Overall, it is a good news/bad news situation. Although, I see it as mostly good news.

When I compared the income from Sunday collections from 2019 and 2020, I found that our collections were down about seven percent. This is not terrible since our overall Mass attendance has been down by a much larger percentage. Many of you have made a serious commitment to support our church even in the most difficult times. Thank you.

I was also informed this past week that the Payroll Protection Program (PPP) which we received last year will be renewed. However, we will not qualify. It will only be available to those who have lost 25 percent of their revenue. In other words, there is no safety net for us this year.

On the expense side, we have been able to use our Maintenance Fund for the major church repairs. This has kept us from going to savings and/or our operations account. Thank you to those who make regular donations to the Maintenance Fund.

What has me most concerned are the outstanding bills. Our unpaid Diocesan Service Appeal (DSA) for 2020 is most pressing. The last report I saw has us still owing over \$30,000. The DSA for 2021 will be at least this amount if not more. In addition to this, we were told that our healthcare cost will increase, and our property insurance will also go up. We were told to expect an increase anywhere between five and ten percent. It will be another large expense that will be due by the end of the year.

Thank you for continuing to support our parish financially.
