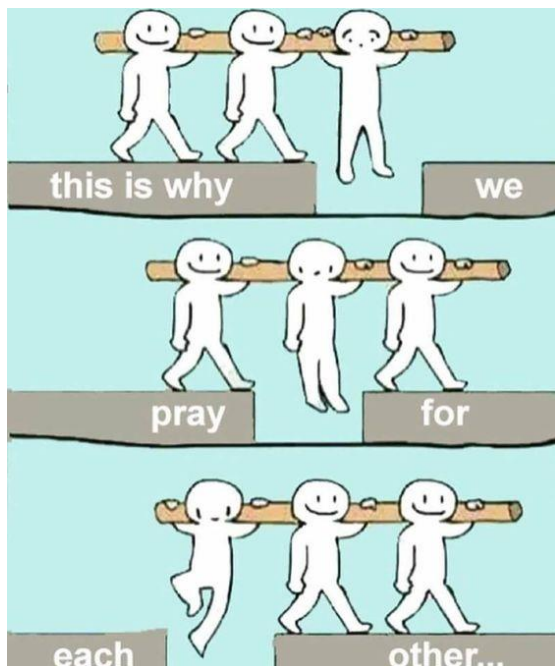
## **RESPECT LIFE MONTH**
