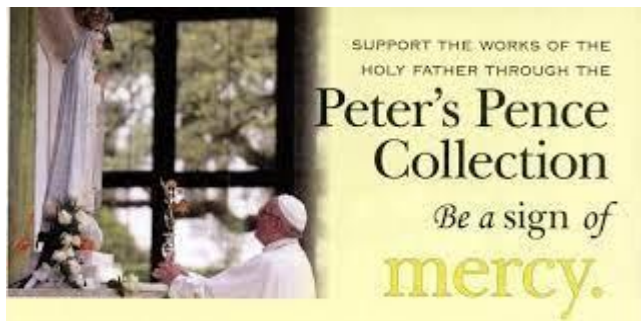


LOST KEYS
