## **PRISON MINISTRY**

After 28 months of lockdown due to COVID at Keen Mt. State Prison in Oakwood, VA, the monthly, interdenominational bible study resumed in July. I accompanied 13 fellow Kairos members, representing about 12 Protestant churches in Roanoke, to the prison to meet with willing inmates. I was allowed to visit a dormitory of 'non-violent' inmates, a large room with bunk beds for 150 of the more than 900 men being held at the facility. The chaplain thanked us for the greeting cards and looks forward to receiving the religious books that our prison ministry will ship to him in August.
