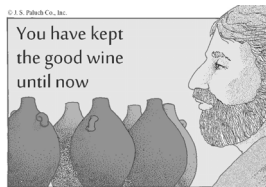

##### YEAR OF MERCY: SHARE MERCY



"It is my burning desire that, during this Jubilee, the Christian people may reflect on the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. It will be a way to reawaken our conscience, too often grown dull in the face of poverty. And let us enter more deeply into the heart of the Gospel where the poor have a special experience of God's mercy. . . . The preaching of Jesus is made visible once more in the response of faith which Christians are called to offer by their witness. ##### HOW TO PRAY THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

Using an ordinary rosary, with five decades of beads:

1. Make the sign of the cross
2. Pray an Our Father and Hail Mary, and say the Apostles' Creed.
3. On the large bead of the first decade, pray: "Eternal Father, I offer you the body and blood, soul and divinity of your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world."
4. On the 10 small beads that follow, pray: "For the sake of his sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world."
5. Repeat the prayers of steps three ("Eternal Father ...") and four ("For the sake of his sorrowful Passion ..."), on the remaining beads (for a total of five decades).
6. Conclude by praying the following prayer three times: "Holy God, holy Mighty One, holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world."

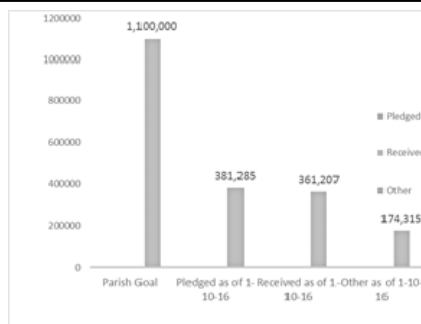
### CCE BINGO
