CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION



Saturday, June 3, following the 4pm Mass, the Parish will commemorate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance, then a procession with the monstrance out of the Church and around the building, stopping on each directional side to read a scripture passage and to sing a hymn. Once we all re-enter the Cathedral we will have Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

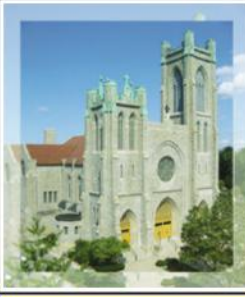
