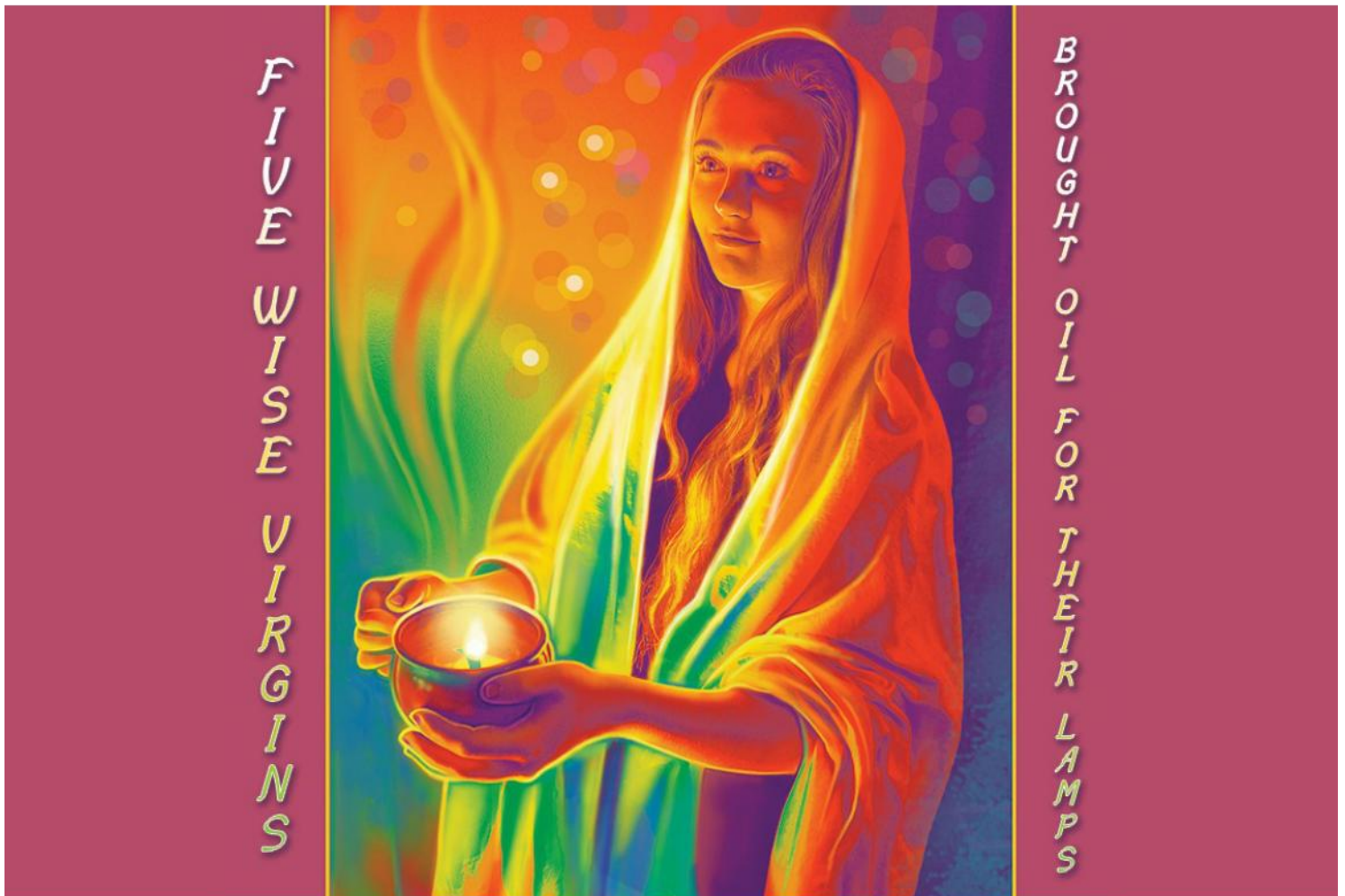

Continue to pray for the country and each other. Hard fought races come from deep convictions and dialing down the intensity sometimes takes a bit of time. We are still a much divided nation on many important issues. Living in a melting pot well takes grace. Seeing one who disagrees with me as a person and not an enemy (or choose some other derogatory comment) requires love. Cooperating with grace and love are choices.

In addition to praying, to help cultivate love and grace, think of two or three genuinely good things about the person you did not vote for and be sure to say those in a conversation. You might be surprised how much that helps change the tenor of a discussion and the tenor of your heart. Unity and love come from choices, they do not just happen.

As always, pray for all of our leaders. No one can lead well without the prayers of their people. Praying for someone is simply asking for God's will for him or her. It is not complicated. While I pray for all of our leaders, I find myself doing it most often for leaders with whom I most disagree. I know the grace helps them and the prayers keep my heart free from fear and anger. Praying for the virtue of hope is also helpful in this endeavor.

Stewardship for Saints and Scholars

Our diocesan capital campaign is underway. We are just shy of 25 percent of our goal of \$825,000, and are moving into the next phase. I have not talked about it much since the presentation at Mass. Hopefully everyone has received a letter from Bishop Boyea asking you to contribute. Some of you have been contacted by parishioners. I am expecting that everyone has been praying for God's grace and discernment.

The overall goal of the campaign is to strengthen our Catholic schools and move toward making it affordable for anyone who wants a Catholic education. We have a great treasure in our Catholic school system for forming our youth that takes real resources to both strengthen and sustain.

A reminder that 20 percent of what we collect comes back to the parish to help with Home School Support, Religious education for our kids, and ongoing adult faith formation.

Grateful for all those who have already contributed to this five year campaign. I have made my pledge, which was actually more than the last diocesan campaign. My God bless your generosity.

Butter, pies, dinner rolls.

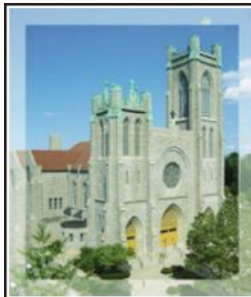
**RECONCILIATION/COMMUNION FOR CHILDREN**
