

DAILY MASS FOR LENT

During Lent, millions of Catholics, throughout the world attend daily Mass, the greatest of Lenton devotions. Weekday Mass, at St. Joseph's, is at 8:00 a.m. in the Main Church. Stations of the Cross are conducted in the main Church each Wednesday at 12:10 p.m. and each Friday at 7:00 p.m. (in English) and 8:00 p.m. (in Spanish).

GOOD FRIDAY: A DAY OF FAST, ABSTINENCE; LENTEN FRIDAYS ARE DAYS OF ABSTINENCE

FASTING requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken, during the day, to maintain physical strength, but these two meals, together, should not equal a full meal in quantity. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues until age 59. Those not specifically obligated to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.

ABSTINENCE prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout their entire life. Those not specifically obligated to abstain from eating meat are encouraged to join in this discipline to the extent that they are able.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross will be offered in the main

Church on Wednesdays at 12:10 p.m. and on Fridays at 7:00 p.m. in English and at 8:00 p.m. in Spanish. Friday Stations of the Cross began on **February 19**; Wednesday Stations of the Cross will begin on **February 24**. Social



distancing and the wearing of masks are required and all are asked to remain in their pews.



FIRST READING

From the Book of Genesis (Gn 9:8-15)

God said to Noah and to his sons with him:

From the First Letter of St. Peter (1Pt 3:18-22)

Beloved:

Christ suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that He might lead you to God. Put to death in the flesh. He was brought to life in the Spirit. In it He also went to preach to the spirits in prison. who had once been disobedient while God patiently waited in the days of Noah during the building of the ark, in which a few persons, eight in all, were saved through water. 
