Prayer and Faith Sharing: An original prayer appropriate for the meeting was read. Part of the gospel for today was read and reflected upon.

Ministry Updates:

- Lectors --There is an adequate number of lectors for Sundays.
- Decorating Donn will check with Russ for what all has to be done for the Triduum and Easter, such as ordering lillies, etc. The palms for Palm Sunday have been donated the past couple of years. The Knights of Columbus have been stripping them, so we assume they will do it again this year. Some Sego palms are needed for Easter.
- Hispanic Ministry The ministry workshop was held February 18, with 20 people attending. Maria will meet with the ministry heads and review the document she created last year pertaining to the various responsibilities and tasks for the Triduum. Good Friday stations of the cross will held inside because the road noise was not conducive to a prayerful experience. A Lenten reflection will be held Saturday, March 11, from 4 to 6:30 pm. There is Mass at 7 pm on Wednesdays during Lent.
- Music There will be instruments accompanying the choir for the Vigil and for Easter morning. The teen group will cover the 6 pm Mass on Easter. The Hand Bell Choir will be ready for the Vigil and for Easter. Charles accompanied the teen group on a retreat to Steubenville, and shared some ideas for encouraging congregational singing.

Triduum and Easter – The Mens Choir will sing on Holy Thursday and sing the Gloria. The question then was which Mass service music should be sung. The RCIA candidates are the ones getting their feet washed. Charles and Barb will discuss the old testament readings and psalms for the Vigil.
