The Power of Patience

In treating others with a spirit of patience, Pope Francis reminded us that we are called to "look at them ... with God's gaze, knowing how to distinguish their faces from their faults."

He continues, "Rushing and impatience are enemies of the spiritual life. God is love, and those who love do not grow tired or irritable; they do not issue ultimatums. God is patient—God knows how to wait."



Traditionally, patience is considered a virtue "annexed" to fortitude. Through patience, we endure suffering or difficulty for the sake of a greater good. St. Thomas Aquinas describes patience as a means of safeguarding the good of reason against sorrow, lest reason give way to sorrow (Summa Theologiae II-II, 136, Art. 1).

As a fruit of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22), patience is fundamental to Christian life. Having received the Holy Spirit, we are called to "be patient in tribulation" (Romans 12:12) and to "preach the message [of Christ] with great patience" (2 Timothy 4:2).

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our diocese will soon take up the national collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD). Your support for this collection brings hope and change to communities across the country, empowering those living in poverty to transform their neighborhoods into reflections of the Kingdom of God.

For more than 50 years, CCHD has helped low-income people address the root causes ofpovel 1y and injustice- not by providing direct aid, but by funding local organizations that empower individuals to make positive and lasting changes in their own communities through leadership training and opportunities for action.

I would like to share a few inspiring examples of the transforming work made possible through your generous suppol 1 of this collection:

- * Together, New Orleans partnered with local government officials to improve hurricane response effolls. With a CCH D grant, they installed commercial-grade solar arrays on strategically located churches and community buildings that serve as emergency shelters. The success of their 15 "CommunityLighthouses" pilot project led the State of Louisiana to allocate \$200 million to expand the program to 345 sites statewide
- * In Minnesota's Twin Ci ties, the Sustainable Farming Association offers workshops and mentoring to help small farmers and ranchers build thriving, environmentally responsible businesses. A CCHD grant expanded their effol 1s to include programs on soil improvement, financial management, and mental health.
- * In New Mexico, La Cosecha Community-Supported Agriculture, a cooperative farming network, used a CCHD grant to operate a food co-op serving low-income families, market locally grown organic produce to institutions, and provide food education to local students.


This record of success demonstrates how your contributions to CCHD bring rea l, lasting change to vulnerable and under-resourced communities across the nation.


When you give to the CCHD collection, you make an impact both nationally and locally. Because 25% of the collection remains in our diocese, we are able to:

- * Provide formation on Catholic Social Teaching to parish leaders seeking tools for advocacy and outreach;
- * Support ministries in rural parishes serving incarcerated men and women and their families;
- *Assist parishes and schools in participating in Catholic Days at the Capitol, helping to cover registration and travel expenses so that more Catholics can put their faith into action.
