



Tai Chi for Arthritis and Fall Prevention is an evidence-based falls prevention program.

TCAFP was created by Dr. Paul Lam, an expert and world leader in the field of Tai Chi for Health Programs. Tai Chi is an ancient Chinese practice of slow, continuous, whole-body movements, strung together one after another in "forms." The forms are learned step-bystep in a specific order, so it is important to come to as many classes as possible.

Classes are held 2x a week, for 6 weeks, and are taught by Certified TCAFP instructors.






