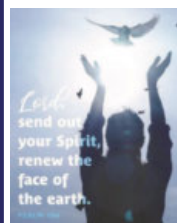
Welcome Back, Fr. Remmy!

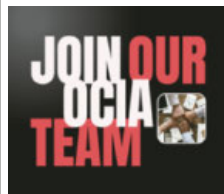

OCIA Ministry – Sponsors & Team Members Needed



The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) is the process by which adults join or complete their initiation into the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

The OCIA Team is currently seeking:

- ◆ *Sponsors* – Practicing Catholics to accompany a Catechumen or Candidate on their faith journey. Sponsors attend key liturgies (some Sundays and special Masses); weekly sessions are encouraged but not required. Training provided.
- ◆ *Inquiry Session Helpers* – Well-catechized individuals to assist with monthly sessions for those exploring the faith. With enough volunteers, commitment could be as little as once per quarter.
- ◆ *OCIA Team Members* – We are looking for individuals to serve on the team in both support roles and as facilitators for various OCIA sessions.
