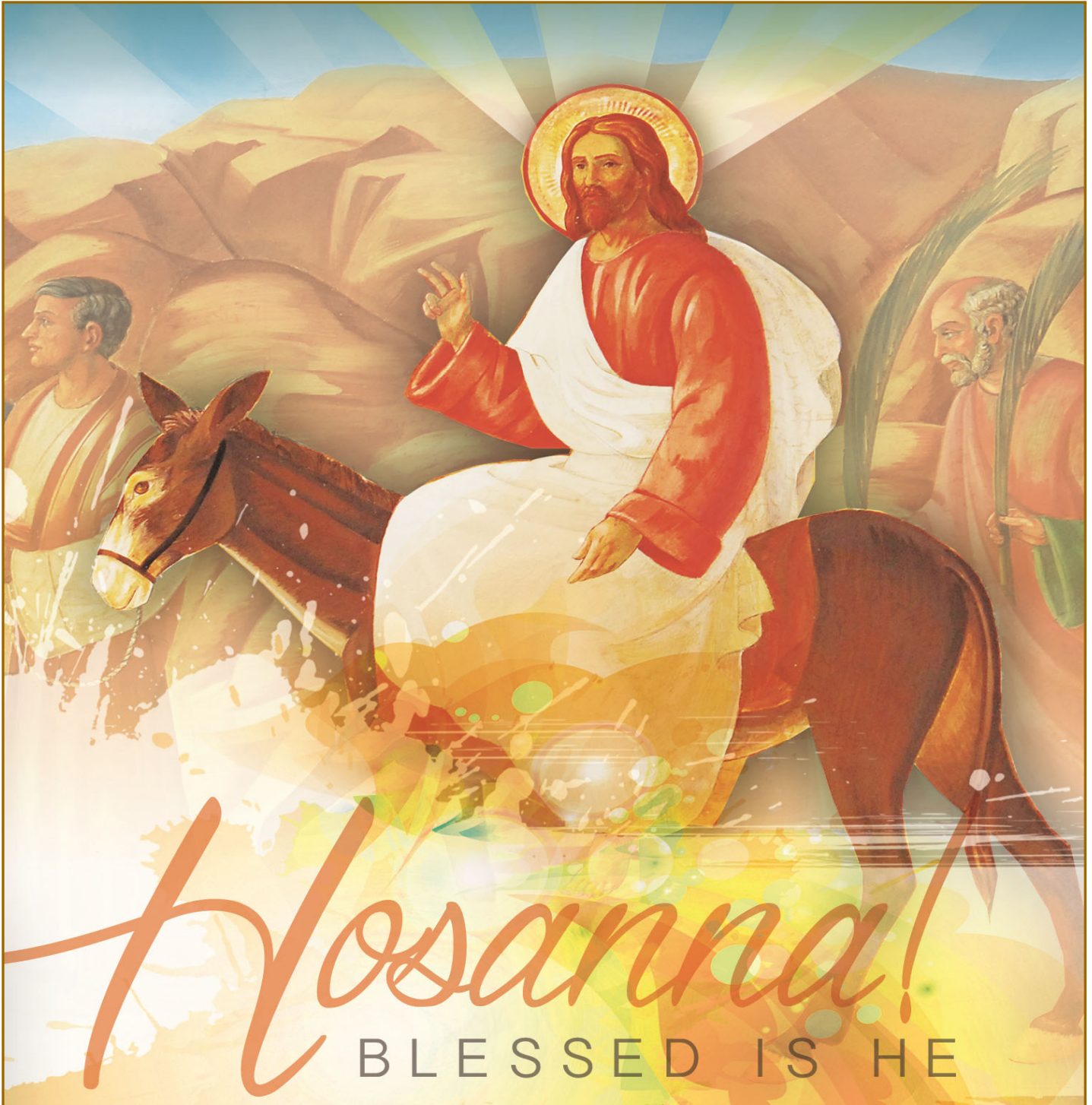

THE TRIDUUM IS COMING!

The Triduum – a Latin word that means “three days” - is a single celebration of the Paschal Mystery presented, over three days, under different aspects. The term Paschal Mystery is used to refer to the passion, death, and resurrection of Christ. It is the core of our faith and the source of our salvation.

The **first** day of the Triduum, the Christian Passover, is from Holy Thursday sunset until Good Friday sunset; it is the day of Jesus’ death, and has been likened to the sixth day of creation, when God formed us from clay and breath. The **second** day of the Triduum, from Good Friday sunset until Holy Saturday sunset, is the Paschal Sabbath, the day of rest. In burial, the Lord rested, and we rest in Him (even from liturgy).

The **third** day of the Triduum, beginning Holy Saturday at sunset, is the great surprise, the Easter surprise.

This third day begins with the holiest night of the year, the Vigil of Easter, leading into the day of days, the Queen of Feasts – celebration of Easter.

In these liturgies, we experience the essence of our faith and enter into a special kind of remembering as we commemorate the actions of Christ. Christian remembering is more than retracing the Lord’s steps during his last days in Jerusalem; it is “being present” at His last days and resurrection. At the Holy Thursday Eucharist, the Church is already drawn into the whole event of Jesus’ death and resurrection. The Good Friday celebration of the Lord’s passion is austere but never sad, for the risen Lord already reigns triumphant. On Holy Saturday the Church waits for the celebration of Christ’s resurrection and its own at the Easter Vigil, when the Spirit hovers over the waters of the font and the community of faith drinks deeply again of the mystery of Jesus’ passage from death to life.


We invite you to join us as we embrace this special time in the liturgical life of the parish.


Good Friday
