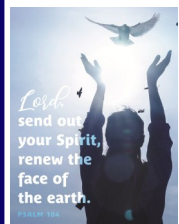

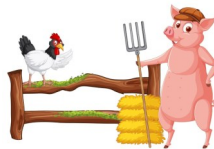

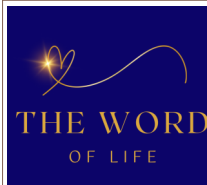

THE VOCATIONAL JOURNEY OF FATHER RANDY RECKER - *I'm telling you - Jesus is Alive!*

I would love to tell you that I have always had a deep relationship with God, but I cannot. However, I would like to share with you my own personal journey and how the presence of God has completely transformed every aspect of my life. I was born into a Catholic family in a small farming community in eastern Iowa called Dyersville, being the younger of two children, just myself and my brother, who is one year older than I.

If you have ever seen the movie Field of Dreams with Kevin Costner, then you've seen my hometown, as it was filmed on location there. My father was a factory worker at John Deere Tractor Works, and my mother was the senior buyer for a company called Modernfold that produced doors, cubicles and room dividers for schools and businesses. Both of my parents are deceased, with my mother passing away in 2014 and my father in 2018.

Growing up, I had a very vague concept of God and who he was in my life. Yes, I attended 12 years of Catholic school and received all the sacraments, but we were taught that our value and worth came from what we had achieved and what we had attained. At the age of 18, neither working in a factory nor farming sounded particularly appealing to me, so after a year at Northeast Iowa Technical Institute studying accounting I headed to the city of Chicago to seek a future outside of a small town.

Over the next three to four years, I would work a veritable host of jobs that included being a bill collector, a warehouse worker and a vacuum cleaner salesperson, no less. Without a doubt, the most memorable and most rewarding job I had was working with the mentally handicapped. They played such a huge part in my human formation just by being themselves, flaws and all. I took a lot away from my brief time with them, and they left an indelible mark on my soul, just as our Lord has done so very often over the years.

In 1989, I found myself again looking for a change and I took a leap of faith, becoming a silent partner in a boat rental business in Islamorada, Florida. Unfortunately, that would only last for three short years. So, at the ripe old age of 26, I found myself, 500 miles from home, away from all my family and friends, and had lost everything - everything except the Midwest work ethic my upbringing had provided.

I stayed in Florida and started to rebuild my life from the ground up working in boat yards and boat dealerships. During this time I never felt like I had left the Church, but I wasn't regularly practicing my faith and I certainly did not know Jesus. I managed to get back on my feet financially and subsequently moved into the greater Ft. Lauderdale area in 1995 to work in the boat business as a boat lift operator and boat mechanic for competitive speedboats. Later, I received a call from a previous employer about an investment opportunity.

I had worked in lawn service between jobs for a year, and it was the owner of that business who called and offered me the business with no money down. I accepted and took ownership in the year 2000. I was owner/operator of Broward Lawn Service for 20 years up until my entry into the seminary.

So how exactly did I end up in the seminary? Good question. I was approaching my 45th birthday and somehow knew the time had come to return to the Church, to ask for God's mercy and forgiveness and to invite Him into my life. After a year of attending Mass, learning when to stand, sit, and kneel on cue, I began to become bored. I would come diligently each Sunday, confined to my same spot, in the same pew, every week for 45 minutes, only to leave empty and unfulfilled.

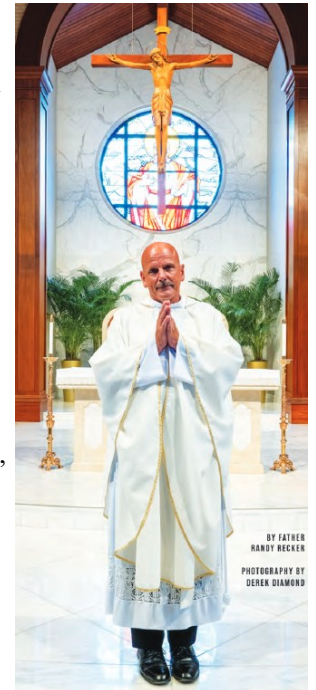
Surely there must be more to all this I told myself, but what? Why are all these people coming back week after week? Why am I? It was then that I responded to a bulletin posting for the men's Emmaus retreat. Little did I know that it would change my life forever. It was there that I met Jesus, and it was there that I invited the Holy Spirit into all areas of my life, not just some. The retreat became the oasis that I had been searching for all those many years, and it was the spark that ignited my love for God and his people.

Although I had often cursed the hard labor of the lawn service and questioned its purpose in my life, it was the freedom of self-employment that allowed God to begin his work in me. After the retreat, my world was turned upside down, shaken and stirred six ways from Sunday. I started with volunteering in the parish prayer garden, and there, our Lord did much of his initial work in me. He began a massive reconstruction project in me that is still ongoing as he drew me closer and closer over the course of 10 years. I was engulfed by my Church and loved every minute of it but kept asking myself where this was leading. I was no longer driven to succeed in the secular world but was keenly focused on the spiritual gifts made available to me.

I ultimately received my certification as a spiritual director following a three-year program and it was in my final year, 2020, that the Lord revealed further his plan for me. I began to know for certain he was asking me to discern the priesthood. I eventually connected with our diocese, first through Father Tim Holeda and then through Msgr. Steve Bosso, who assisted me in preparing to start priestly formation at Sacred Heart Seminary in Franklin, Wisconsin.

By August of 2020 I had sold everything I had, packed my car and drove to Wisconsin to begin formal studies for the priesthood. Through the grace of God, years later here I am, an ordained Catholic priest.

These first years of priestly ministry have been trial by fire in many ways, but more than that it has been a constant opportunity to trust him entirely, everyday. *Most certainly I can tell you that Jesus is alive.*

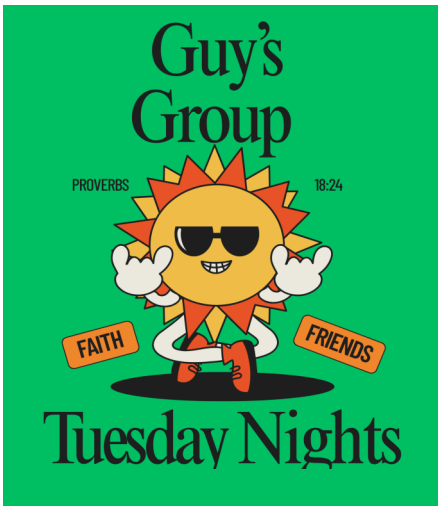

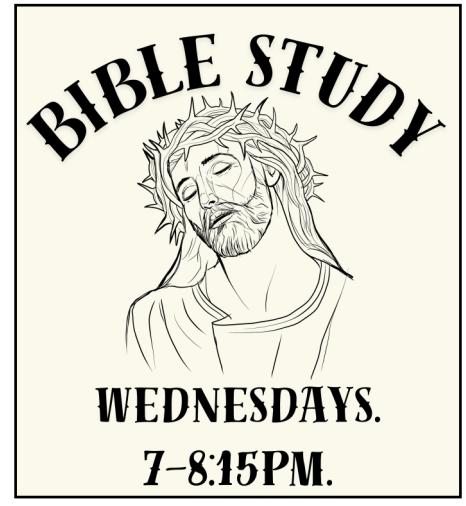
