TEACHING MASS AND ICE CREAM SOCIAL

Lots of people who are Catholic and have been attending Mass for years realize that they don't know why things happen the way they do at Mass. And why should they? If you are like most people, you last learned about the Mass in your Faith Formation class (probably called CCD at the time), and that was a long time ago. Some of you might have had wonderful liturgical experiences in high school or college, and even helped to plan Masses, but that doesn't necessarily mean that you learned the names for everything used at Mass or know why this prayer say "this" and that prayer says "that."

Two years ago, when we hosted the Teaching Mass during the summer months, almost 100 people came and greatly enjoyed the opportunity to learn a little more about the Mass we celebrate each weekend. We hope that with summer's longer days and lighter schedules, we will see a similar group this year.

The Teaching Mass will be held on **Sunday**, **August 14**, **at 6 p.m.** in the Church. It will be a regular Sunday liturgy — although it will last longer than a normal Mass. We will begin by giving you some background information about the Church, the vessels, the sanctuary, and the clothing worn by the priest and altar servers. We will then celebrate Mass together. Fr. Joe will take opportunities within the Mass to pause and help everyone understand more about each particular part of the Mass and how we can more fully understand and engage in it.



When Mass is over, come to the Parish Center and enjoy an ice cream sundae and the community gathered. Mass and ice cream are a great combination!

People of all ages are welcome. Children as young as second grade have participated in the past and have done well and learned a lot. Lots of our parishioners found it to be helpful and a great place to ask questions about things they have always wondered about. Many of our older parishioners have found it to be really helpful — especially those who lived through the changes after the Second Vatican Council but never had the chance to learn a great deal about those changes.
