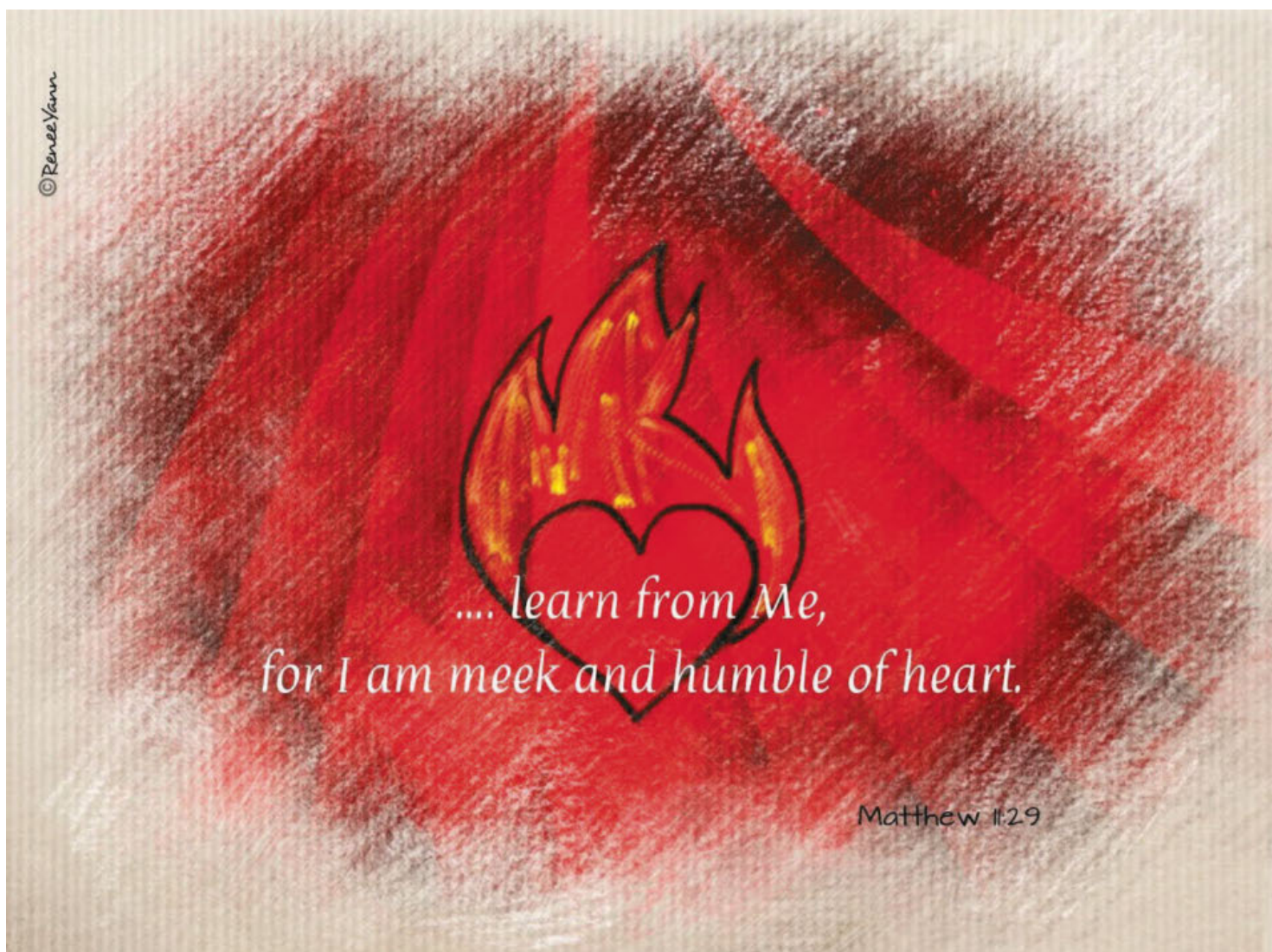

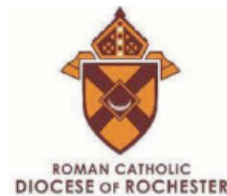

## **FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOHN**

*Who is Fr. John Orenge Omboga?*

I was born on December 15, 1965, second last, almost the baby, in a family of eight children in what was then Nyanza Province, currently Kisii County, in Kenya.

I attended school in Narok County, and when I completed high school, I joined the major seminary from Ngong Diocese in 1988. I was ordained a priest on March 30, 1996.

I was assigned to work as parochial vicar for one-and-a-half years in my first parish in Kajiado County, then was made Fr.-in-Charge at a parish in Narok County, which was near my home and my family – only a five-hour drive! I was then made Fr. Rector for three years at a high school, also in Narok County.

In the fall of 2006, I joined the graduate program in human resource development at St. John Fisher College (now University) in upstate New York. I lived and assisted at Our Lady of Lourdes in Brighton, near Rochester. I graduated in May of 2008 and was sent to Hornell for two months, then was assigned to Our Lady of the Lakes Parish in Penn Yan until July of 2010, when I returned to Kenya.

Back in Kenya, I worked as moderator in charge of the Diocesan Secretariat until April 18, 2018. Concurrently, I also served as Fr.-in-Charge of the parish of Our Lady of Fatima from December 2013 until June 2019. Then I was assigned to St. Joseph the Worker Parish in Kenya until May 2022.

Having recently returned to New York State, I will coordinate the Missionary Cooperation plan for my Diocese of Ngong in collaboration with the Propagation of Faith offices in the dioceses of the U.S.A. and Canada.

I spent a few weeks at the parishes of St. Maximilian Kolbe and St. Katharine Drexel as I waited to be assigned. I was assigned to work with Fr. John, the pastor of the cluster of Blessed Sacrament, St. Mary, and St. Boniface in Rochester, until I was appointed temporary pastoral administrator of All Saints Parish, Corning, in September 2022, where I worked until I was appointed pastoral administrator of St. Catherine of Siena.

I am ready to work with you and to learn from you, to enhance the kingdom of God here on Earth.

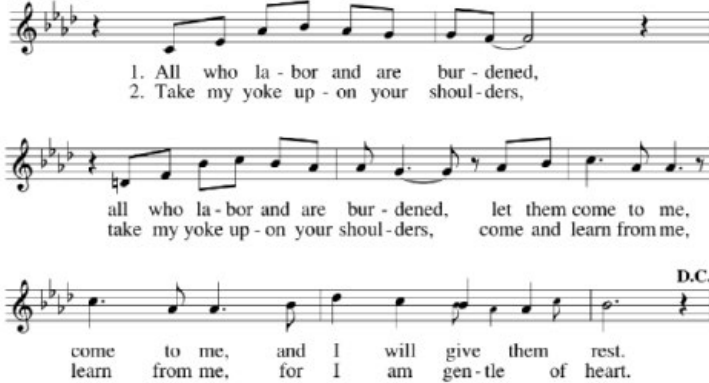

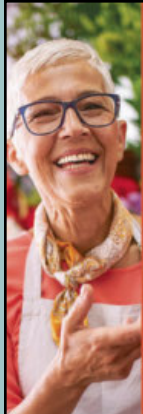

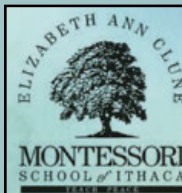
