3. Follow-up on discussion of essential ministries and programs at St. Catherine's Sacraments and Faith Formation are mandated by the Diocese. These are progressing and are a high staff priority. Pastoral Care and Social Justice helps define who we are as a parish and our priorities. Let's take a deeper dive into Pastoral Care;

Pastoral Care Discussion: In our role as PC, we should be aware of concerns, hear suggestions, gain ideas, and be there for parishioners. The suggestion boxes have been temporarily removed. Some parishioners have shared that they appreciate the connection at the church despite COVID, the uncertainty and resulting anxiety remains high among most of us, hundreds are watching on-line that aren't quite ready to return, but we want to remain connected with them.

How can we help people feel more connected (whether they attend or not)?

Parishioners can join our meetings to share concerns, issues, questions, ideas or suggestions for the first fifteen minutes of our monthly meetings. An invite needs to be made in the bulletin saying that interested parishioners email the PC Chair with their name, email or phone and a one sentence description of their topic, question or interest. Steve will then contact them, explain parameters if needed (each person has a five minute limit or so depending on number of people, 3 people each time max structured by Steve). The invite should go into the bulletin every other month and we can dedicate the first fifteen minutes of the agenda for this purpose. The invite in the bulletin should list the next two meeting dates and time (ex: for Nov and Dec) and that way people can choose what date works best for them and us. For example; next PC meetings are on the second Mondays - Nov 9 and Dec 14. Steve will send the invite to Jane by Mon, Oct 26 for Nov 1 bulletin and Nov 23 for the Dec 6 bulletin.

Parishioners can also email the general email and it will get forwarded to Steve.
