Sacrament of First Reconciliation

Saturday, March 11th, 2023 10:00 am

Attendance is mandatory. Parents are invited and it is required that you stay with your child. You are welcome to come into the Church and sit in the pews along the back of the church. We ask that you please try not to bring siblings if possible. The children will sit with their class & once they have received the sacrament and said their penance they are allowed to leave.

Sacrament of First Communion

Saturday, May 6, 2023

Monday Classes – 10:00am; Wednesday Classes – 1:00pm

The Communion Program is a 2 year program which includes grades first and second. The curriculum uses a video based program called “Blessed” by Dynamic Catholic, in addition to other resources & activities which complement the program.

The children will receive their sacraments in the Second Grade.

Please provide a copy of your child’s Baptismal Certificate to the Religious Education office if they were baptized in a church other than St. Patrick’s in Armonk.

More details regarding rehearsals (mandatory) & mass times will be distributed via your CCD teachers in 2023.

Boys: Suit or Sports Jacket/Dress slacks with white dress shirt and tie (required).

Girls: White dress with veil/headpiece (optional). Please no flowers worn or carried during the ceremony & no gloves or purses.
