

I recently came across a line from the great saint, Ambrose of Milan, who, in reference to the Apostles said: "God did not call philosophers, but fishermen." This is certainly a statement that is factually true, but even more importantly, it cuts to the heart of Jesus' call to each one of us: we are called to a life of radical discipleship. Discipleship is not a matter of **where** we have been, but rather a matter of whom we are following!

Discipleship consists of two parts, both explained by Jesus in this weekend's Gospel. We are called to repent, that is, review and change our lives, and then "come after" Jesus in order that we might invite others to follow Him.

After the deeply moving celebration of Christmas and the excitement of Cardinal Dolan's visit last Saturday, it seems to me that we, both as a parish and as individuals, are being called by Jesus to allow Him to change our lives so that we may be better disciples. I invite you to spend some time in prayer this week considering what it is that God is asking each one of us to do.
