From the Pastor

Today we celebrate the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist. Thus far in Luke's Gospel, we have alternated between the births and coming of age of John and Jesus. Here we find that John's ministry has brought many to him and spread an eager hopefulness that he is the long-awaited messiah. John, however, is clear about his role and baptizing ministry as leading people to repentance to prepare the way for the one to come. He presents himself as the Isaian voice crying out in the wilderness proclaiming forgiveness, mercy and the coming revelation of the glory of God.

In Isaiah's original context, the prophet proclaims the Word of God as the hope for return from exile and restoration of God's people to their land and union with God. The evangelists envision this hope in the person of John the Baptist, who prepares the people for restoration and reunion with God through the coming messiah. John's baptism of Jesus inaugurates the revelation of the glory of God as the Holy Spirit descends upon Jesus, who is affirmed as Son.

The letter to Titus characterizes this mission as God's great gift to mankind, given as a loving, Spirit-sharing Savior who leads us into righteousness through his life and sacrifice lived with and for us. Baptism into this mission is just the beginning.
