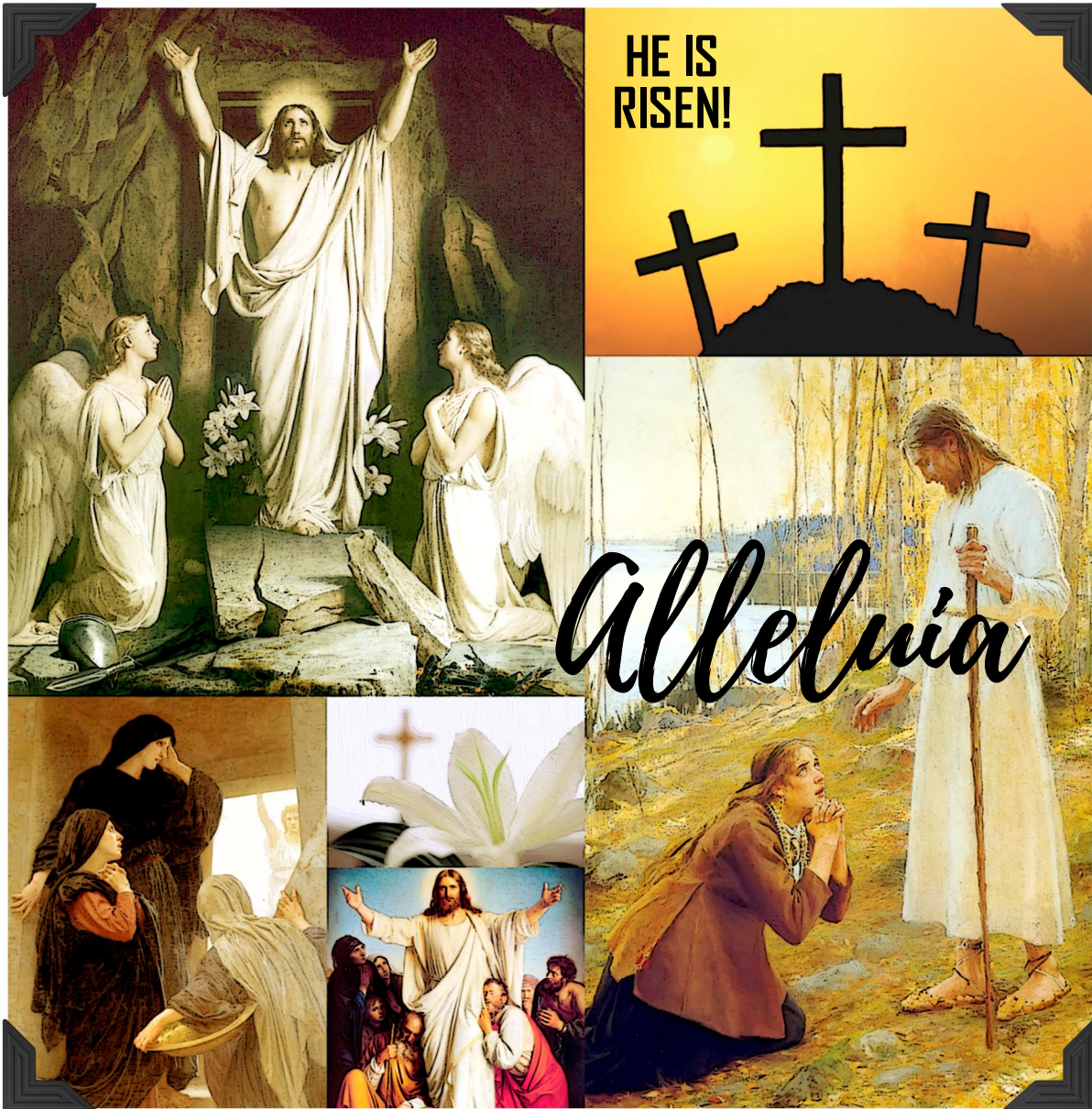

Golden Jubilee

The Archdiocese of New York's *Golden Jubilee Wedding Mass* will take place on Sunday, June 1st at 2:30 pm at St. Patrick's Cathedral. The Mass is for couples celebrating 50 years of marriage in 2025. His Eminence, Cardinal Dolan will be officiating. All who wish to attend this Mass will need to register with the Parish and will be given a ticket for admission. All Golden Jubilee couples will receive a commemorative certificate. Couples who are unable to attend the Mass can request a certificate through their parish. Registration will close on Monday, May 12. Please call or visit the Rectory to register.

Divine Mercy Sunday

In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know that feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000. On this day the Lord promises great graces for those who turn to Him with trust for mercy, forgiveness, healing, and restoration.

Jesus told St. Faustina: "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy."

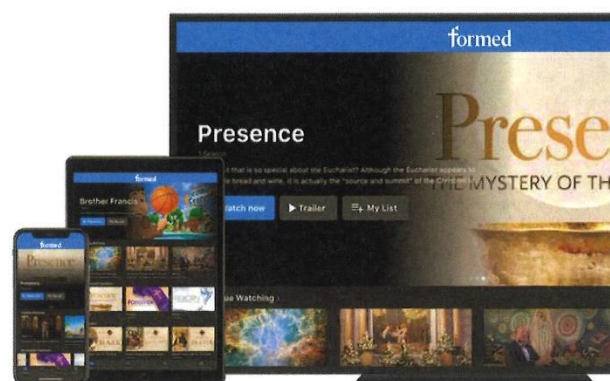
