Novena to our Lady of Pompeii

A few years ago one of my friends asked me to pray a Novena to Our Lady of Pompeii for a very special intention. At that time I did not know anything about that novena, I never heard about it in the seminary, I just heard about it from some devoted Catholics. But I never bothered to learn more about it until that time when my friend asked me to pray that novena for his very special intention. He is my good friend so I said, "yes I will pray."

After I agreed I learned that this novena is for 54 days and you pray at least three mysteries of the rosary, Joyful, Sorrowful and Glorious mysteries. You can add also the Luminous mysteries to that novena. So three full rosaries a day seemed a lot to pray for me, but I promised my friend so I started. After few days of praying the novena I realized that it's not that hard and I had time to do my other duties. Moreover, praying three full rosaries a day gave me a lot of peace and joy. So by praying for my friend's special intention I gained grace also for myself. Before I even finished the novena my friend's prayer request was miraculously answered.

After that visible sign that this novena is very powerful I started to talk about it. Many people who believed me and started to pray that novena received many miracles. The best example is my mom who after she started that novena two years ago prays it almost all the time. I myself prayed that novena a few times already and I am praying one right now. The times I do not pray the novena I pray the Holy Rosary every day. I cannot imagine my priesthood life without praying the rosary every day. Mary is Our Mother, "when we pray the rosary she is kneeling in front of God's throne and interceding for our petitions." Offer to her your worries; ask for her intersession every day, she won't disappoint you. Mary will always lead you to Jesus.
