From Fr. Henry Pinto

Something that I learned from my parents was to always be grateful, I know how important is to repeat the word "Thanks" as many times as necessary, for that reason, being aware of this necessity of thankfulness, I want to start this little note giving thanks to the Almighty God for all that I have received from Him, then to all of you at Saint Michael parish for welcoming me into your family.

I really have to confess how grateful I am now for all the blessings that I have received over the years; about four and a half years ago, I had the opportunity to come to this country to finish with my studies of theology. I went to Holy Apostles College and Seminary in Cromwell Connecticut and at the same time I was assigned to Saint Joseph parish in West Milford as seminarian and where I also served as deacon for one year. Finally, I was ordained to the priesthood July 1 by Bishop Arthur Serratelli in the Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist in Paterson.

During my four years at Saint Joseph I met so many people and I had the opportunity to share my faith with them, bringing them closer to Christ and to each other, working with our youth and children, altar servers, married couples and in many others ways. But now as a new ordained priest, I have the privilege of being assigned to your community to begin my priestly ministry as Parochial Vicar at Saint Michael Parish.

My journey with you has begun and with great joy I want to say Thanks again to all of you, my Saint Michael's Family for allowing me to be with you. I am very glad to come to know you and begin to be part of your spiritual lives. This is one of the greatest privileges of our ministry as priests. I hope to share with you many celebrations in which we can give new life to our faith and increase our joy for the gospel.

May the Lord bless you abundantly; you are all in my prayers. Fr. 
