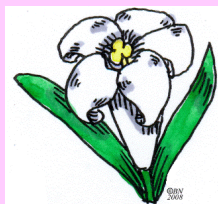

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE PASCUA

Primera Lectura: Hechos 5:12-16

La gente tenía a los apóstoles en gran estima y les llevó gente enferma para que fueran curados. A pesar de que algunos tenían miedo de que se les reconociera, el número de seguidores de Jesús continuaba en aumento.

Segunda Lectura: Apocalipsis 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19
Juan describe una visión de candelabros de oro y alguien de apariencia humana, vestido de largo y con un cinturón de oro. La aparición le dijo a Juan que no temiera y luego se describió como el que ha muerto pero que ahora vive. Luego indicó a Juan que anotara cualquier otra visión que tuviera.

Evangelio: San Juan 20:19-31

Jesús se apareció a los discípulos y sopló sobre ellos diciendo “Reciban el Espíritu Santo”. Les otorgó el poder de perdonar o no los pecados de la gente. Tomás, quien no estaba presente, rehusó creer que Jesús había aparecido hasta que El regreso a ellos una vez más. Jesús dijo a Tomás que creyera y agregó: “¡Dichosos los que creen sin haber visto!”.



Segundo Domingo de Pascua

24 de abril de 2022

“... Llegó Jesús y poniéndose en medio de ellos, les dijo: ‘¡La paz esté con ustedes!’. Mientras decía esto, les mostró sus manos y su costado. Los discípulos se llenaron de alegría cuando vieron al Señor. Jesús les dijo de nuevo: ‘¡La paz esté con ustedes! Como el Padre me envió a mí, yo también los envío a ustedes’. Al decirles esto, sopló sobre ellos y añadió ‘Reciban al Espíritu Santo. Los pecados serán perdonados a los que ustedes se los perdonen, y serán retenidos a los que ustedes se los retengan’.”

Después de la Pascua, encontramos maravillosos momentos cuando el Señor Resucitado se presenta a Sí Mismo a los apóstoles y Sus amigos. Abrimos la Puerta al cuarto de arriba, vemos las flores y al jardinero en la tumba vacía, nos sentamos a desayunar a las orillas del mar de Galilea, y caminamos con Cleofás en el camino a Emaús. Pregunto, ¿en dónde está mi fe en la Pascua, alentándome a permanecer cerca del Cristo Resucitado? ¿Tengo Su don hoy del Espíritu Santo en mí? Viva el momento.
