From Deacon John

Homily from July 2, 2023

Mixed messages

In our first reading from the book of 2nd Kings we see charity and hospitality towards a holy prophet being rewarded by God. Yet in our reading from Romans, we hear we are baptized into Christ's death and our Gospel tells us to take up our cross. In one breath it appears that God rewards those who do His will, and in the next breath it appears those who are walking in faith are persecuted or punished. Without looking at the context of the situation and seeing the bigger picture we can easily get confused. The story of the two great prophets in 1st and 2nd book of kings is about God's call to his people to come back to the true faith. The culture at large had abandoned God and fallen into pagan worship, and these two great prophets Elijah and Elisha preached, taught and worked miracles to bring the people back to God. Yet it was not without persecution. The prevailing culture of their day did not want to hear truth. This woman recognized the truth in the preaching of Elisha, and offered charity and hospitality to the man of God, and she was rewarded for her faith in action. Divine providence means that God will be with you and satisfy your needs. There is a big difference between needs and wants. God provides what is best for our eternal soul, not the fleeting desires of our heart.

One of the amazing things that I often hear about, are people who have had a deep conversion of faith, or a reversion into a deeper faith, seem to suddenly be able to work through any difficulties. Prayer comes easier and they get many consolations and graces. They seem to be able to ride a spiritual high through all their cares and worries, and then all of a sudden, things can start to change. This new or deeper foundation of faith can begin to rub their friends or family members the wrong way. Perhaps they think you are better than them or even jealous of your new found peace and confidence. This can escalate into severe conflicts that can actually lead to family members never speaking to each other again! What a price to pay for having faith.

I have a good friend who had such a conversion several years ago, went through R.C.I.A. and entered the Church. He turned his life around, met a very nice woman and was contemplating marriage. Then all of a sudden turmoil and trouble began with his family and friends. They became hostile to him about his new found faith, and the wonderful woman he had met developed breast cancer. He questioned me and said "Was he being abandoned by God? What was he doing wrong?" We talked and prayed about this for a few minutes and then I told him that he did NOTHING wrong! I shared that it was probably because he was doing things right that family and former friends became hostile.

I asked him if he still trusted in God, and he answered that his faith was stronger than ever. I asked did he still love the woman and he replied more than ever. The difference between enduring hardships with faith and being overwhelmed by hardship without faith is the real issue. Before his conversion he would have never been able to be the support and caregiver for this woman. Now his faith and love for her has grown stronger and he has a new circle of friends with similar values.

Faith in Jesus does not always mean prosperity, peaches and cream. It sometimes means hardship, rejection, persecution, and for some martyrdom, but through it all Jesus' love for us is unshakable. Following Jesus Christ is not supposed to be easy, and in the same breath it not just suffering on the cross waiting for Heaven. Following Jesus means that while our true home is in heaven, we take the joy and peace of heaven and share it with others here. I see so many people with no hope, no joy, searching for happiness. They are lonely and depressed, and angry and envious at the world because they are not happy and it has to be someone else's fault. Following Jesus will not always make you happy. Anyone who is happy all the time probably needs to see a psychiatrist.

However, following Jesus will offer you contentment, comfort in your sorrows, and joy in your heart.


