Vigésimo Cuarto Domingo en Tiempo Ordinario 17 de septiembre de 2023

"Perdona el agravio a tu prójimo y entonces, cuando ores, serán absueltos tus pecados. Sí un hombre mantiene su enojo contra otro, ¿cómo pretende que el Señor lo sane? No tiene piedad de un hombre semejante a él iy se atreve a implorar por sus pecados!... no prestes atención a sus faltas ... 'Señor, ¿cuántas veces tendré que perdonar a mi hermano las ofensas que me haga?""

Recitamos El Padre Nuestro y mencionamos que recibiremos el perdón sólo cuando perdonemos a los que nos ofenden. La lecturas de Eclesiástico dan la pauta. No sólo debemos perdonar, sino que debemos descubrir formas de iniciar esa acción.

Uno de los grandes poderes que poseemos es el poder de perdonar. Podemos hacelo, o escoger no otorgar este don cuando alguien nos lo pide. Podemos ofrecerlo cuando se pide, cuando nos damos cuenta de cuán generoso y misericordioso nuestros Dios es con nosotros. El adagio de "perdonar y olvidar" es lindo, pero difícil. Un maravilloso monje me enseñó: 'perdonar y recordar sin amargura.'



VIGESIMOCUARTO DOMINGO EN TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Primera Lectura: Sirac 27:30—28:7

Sirac aconseja a todos a perdonar las faltas de su prójimo. Sólo al perdonar las faltas de otro puede una persona esperar ser perdonada por sus faltas.

Segunda Lectura: Romanos 14:7-9

Pablo recalca que ninguna es su propio amo, tenemos responsabilidad para con el Señor, y le pertenecemos en ambas vida y muerte.

Evangelio: San Mateo 18:21-35

Esta narrativa señala la diferencia entre piedad y justicia. Cuando Pedro pregunta cuán a menudo debe perdonar a alguien que comete una falta contra él, Jesús le responde: "...no te digo hasta siete veces, sino hasta setenta veces siete." Jesús narra la historia del rey que tuvo piedad de su oficial perdonándole todas sus deudas, pero este mismo oficial no tuvo piedad de su propio siervo.
