## Silence of the Church

A few thoughts to share with you from our Holy Father, Pope Francis:

"When we go to Mass, maybe we arrive five minutes before, and we start to chit-chat with those in front of us." However, "it is not a moment for chit-chat."

"It is a moment of silence for preparing ourselves for dialogue, a time for the heart to collect itself in order to prepare for the encounter with Jesus," adding that "silence is so important."

Continuing his new catechesis on the Eucharist, the Pope recalled his message the week prior, that **the Mass** is **not** a show, but a place where we encounter the

<u>Lord</u>. In this encounter, silence is what "prepares us and accompanies us."

But to really understand this, first we have to answer a question. And that is: What is prayer?

Prayer is, "first and foremost dialogue, personal relationship with God." And in prayer, just like in any dialogue, it needs moments of silence "together with Jesus." This, is because it is only in the "mysterious silence of God" that His Word can resound in our heart.

His Holiness explained that to pray is not difficult, and is something that Jesus Himself taught us to do first of all by example, when in the Gospels He withdraws to a secluded place to pray. And second, He teaches us again when He tells His Disciples that the first word in knowing how to pray is "Father."

This is "so simple." "So we have to learn, 'Father." Then, we must take on the attitude of a small child before his or her parents. One full of trust and confidence, knowing that God "remembers you and takes care of you."

The second attitude we should take is one of childlike surprise and wonder. The child, "always asks a thousand questions because they want to discover the world; in our relationship with the Lord, in prayer, wonder," telling pilgrims to "open the heart to wonder."

When it comes to prayer, he noted that often we are busy with many different activities or projects and say we do not have time. "We lose sight of what is fundamental: our life of the heart, our spiritual life, our life of prayer with the Lord."

However, Jesus surprises us in truth by loving us and calling us even in our weaknesses, adding that just as Christ called His Disciples, He also calls us to Him at each Mass.

#### Unas reflexiones para compartirles de nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco:

"Cuando vamos a Misa, tal vez llegamos cinco minutos antes y empezamos a charlar con aquellos que están frente a nosotros." Sin embargo, "no es un momento para charlar".

"Es un momento de silencio para prepararnos para el diálogo, un tiempo para que el corazón se recoja para prepararse para el encuentro con Jesús", añadiendo que "el silencio es tan importante".

Continuando con su nueva catequesis sobre la Eucaristía, el Papa recordó su mensaje de la semana anterior, que la Misa no es un espectáculo, sino un lugar donde encontramos al Señor. En este encuentro, el silencio es lo que "nos prepara y nos acompaña".

Pero para entender realmente esto, primero tenemos que responder a una pregunta. Y esa es: ¿Qué es la oración?

La oración es, "ante todo, diálogo, relación personal con Dios". Y en la oración, al igual que en cualquier diálogo, necesita momentos de silencio "junto con Jesús". Esto se debe a que solo en el "misterioso silencio de Dios" su Palabra puede resonar en nuestro corazón.

Su Santidad explicó que orar no es difícil y es algo que Jesús mismo nos enseñó a hacer primero por ejemplo, cuando en los Evangelios se retira a un lugar apartado para orar. Y segundo, nos enseña de nuevo cuando le dice a sus discípulos que la primera palabra para saber cómo orar es "Padre".

Esto es "tan simple". "Así que tenemos que aprender, 'Padre'". Luego, debemos adoptar la actitud de un niño pequeño ante sus padres. Llena de confianza y seguridad, sabiendo que Dios "te recuerda y cuida de ti".

La segunda actitud que debemos adoptar es la de sorpresa y asombro infantiles. El niño "siempre hace mil preguntas porque quiere descubrir el mundo; en nuestra relación con el Señor, en la oración, asombro", diciendo a los peregrinos que "abran el corazón al asombro".

En cuanto a la oración, señaló que a menudo estamos ocupados con muchas actividades o proyectos diferentes y decimos que no tenemos tiempo. "Perdemos de vista lo fundamental: nuestra vida del corazón, nuestra vida espiritual, nuestra vida de oración con el Señor".

Sin embargo, Jesús nos sorprende en verdad amándonos y llamándonos incluso en nuestras debilidades, agregando que así como Cristo llamó a sus discípulos, también nos llama a Él en cada Misa. ¡En este Adviento, siéntense en silencio por un momento y vean si pueden escucharlo!
