Let His Light Shine

Talk about bursting onto the scene! Of course the demon possessing his man couldn't tolerate being around Jesus. But wouldn't it have been wiser to slink away rather than draw attention to himself?

It happened a lot, in fact. Jesus would show up somewhere or reveal his glory in some way, and his presence would prompt resistance and sometimes even violent outbursts. This wasn't true just of demons. At the very beginning of his ministry, Jesus' announcement of the good news enraged enough people that they tried to push him off a cliff. Then, after only a few weeks of preaching and performing miracles, Jesus upset some Pharisees enough that they began plotting his murder. Not even his closest disciples were immune. Jesus' revelation of God's plan to save us through his cross upset Peter enough that he rebuked Jesus.

In one way or another, we have all reacted strongly against Jesus and his message of salvation. We all have pockets of darkness still lingering in our hearts. Maybe you refused to forgive someone. Maybe you knowingly chose sin in a tempting situation. Or maybe you denigrated a fellow believer who thinks differently than you do. Still, Jesus continues to love you and offer the grace you need to change.

What was true in that synagogue in Capernaum is still true today: the darkness of sin can never overpower the light of Christ. Don't be surprised if you experience some form of opposition to Jesus in your heart today – maybe in prayer or as you're trying to focus at Mass or as an opportunity to serve your family arises. Instead, take comfort from it. Trust that the light of Christ will not only expose your darkness; it can expel it as well.

Permite que Su Luz Brille

¡Hablemos de hacer una entrada espectacular! Por supuesto, el demonio que poseía a este hombre no podía tolerar estar cerca de Jesús. Pero, ¿no habría sido más sabio retirarse en lugar de llamar la atención sobre sí mismo?

De hecho, esto sucedía con frecuencia. Jesús aparecía en algún lugar o revelaba su gloria de alguna manera, y su presencia provocaba resistencia y a veces incluso explosiones violentas. Esto no era exclusivo de los demonios. Al principio de su ministerio, el anuncio de Jesús sobre la buena noticia enfureció a tanta gente que intentaron empujarlo por un precipicio. Luego, después de solo unas semanas de predicar y realizar milagros, Jesús molestó lo suficiente a algunos fariseos como para que comenzaran a planear su asesinato. Ni siquiera sus discípulos más cercanos eran inmunes. La revelación de Jesús sobre el plan de Dios para salvarnos a través de su cruz molestó tanto a Pedro que lo reprendió.

De una forma u otra, todos hemos reaccionado fuertemente contra Jesús y su mensaje de salvación. Todos tenemos rincones de oscuridad que aún persisten en nuestros corazones. Tal vez te hayas negado a perdonar a alguien. Tal vez elegiste conscientemente el pecado en una situación tentadora. O tal vez menospreciaste a un compañero creyente que piensa diferente a ti. Aun así, Jesús sigue amándote y ofreciendo la gracia que necesitas para cambiar.

Lo que fue cierto en esa sinagoga en Capernaum sigue siendo cierto hoy: la oscuridad del pecado nunca puede vencer la luz de Cristo. No te sorprendas si experimentas alguna forma de oposición a Jesús en tu corazón hoy, tal vez en la oración, al intentar concentrarte en la Misa o cuando surge una oportunidad para servir a tu familia. En cambio, encuentra consuelo en ello. Confía en que la luz de Cristo no solo expondrá tu oscuridad; también puede expulsarla.

There will be 3 groups that will meet in the evening on different nights and there will be one day time session.


