Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time August 3, 2025

"There was a rich man whose land produced a bountiful harvest. He asked himself, 'What shall I do, for I do not have space to store my harvest?' And he said, 'This is what I shall do. I shall tear down my barns and build larger ones.' There I shall store all my grain and other goods and say to myself 'Now as for you, you have so many good things stored up for many years, rest, eat, drink and be merry' But God said to him, 'you fool, this night your life will be demanded of you'...Thus will it be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God."

Our highways are dotted with new buildings, extra storage for goods not needed. They replace silos on farms which stored grain for the winter months. What do we find in these new buildings? We can just imagine. The parable of Jesus raises questions for us.

It begins with my admission that whatever I have is God's gift to me. What I have in excess and do not use, is going to waste and could be helpful to someone else. An unused coat or jacket could be of enormous help to a homeless person, or a thrift shop. A rusting bike could make a poor child happy. A set of dishes can be of great assistance for someone whose home was destroyed by fire. Think of one thing you can afford to give away. That is 'what matters to God.'

Décimo Octavo Domingo en Tiempo Ordinario 3 de agosto de 2025

"Había un hombre rico, cuyas tierras habían producido mucho, y se preguntaba a sí mismo "¿Qué voy a hacer? No tengo dónde guardar mi cosecha". Después pensó: "Voy a hacer esto: demoleré mis graneros, construiré otros más grandes y amontonaré allí todo mi trigo y mis bienes, y diré a mi alma: Alma mía, tienes bienes almacenados para muchos años; descansa, come, bebe y date buena vida". Pero Dios le dijo: "Insensato, esta misma noche vas a morir. Esto es lo que sucede al que acumula riquezas para sí, y no es rico a los ojos de Dios."

Nuestras carreteras están llenas de nuevos edificios y bodegas para bienes que no necesitamos. Reemplazan silos de granjas que guardan grano para los meses de invierno. ¿Qué encontramos en estos nuevos edificios? No podemos ni imaginar. La parábola de Jesús nos plantea preguntas.

Comienza con que yo admita que cualquier cosa que tengo es un don de Dios. Lo que tengo en exceso y no utilizo va a desperdiciarse. Podría ser útil para alguien más. Un abrigo o chaqueta que no se usa es de gran ayuda para una persona indigente, o a una tienda de segunda mano. Una bicicleta que se oxida puediera hacer feliz a un niño. Los platos de una vajilla pueden ayudar a alguien que perdió todo en un incendio. Piense en una cosa que puede regalar. Eso es lo que 'le importa a Dios.'
