Get Involved at St. Michael

St. Michael's is blessed with many opportunities to serve Christ and one another through our parish committees and groups. Each committee plays a vital role in strengthening our worship, service, fellowship, and stewardship. We warmly invite you to consider joining one of these groups! The time commitment is limited, and you will be working alongside an established committee with experienced members who will guide and welcome you. Your talents and presence can make a real difference in the life of our parish.

1. *Worship & Liturgical Committees*

Lectors Ministry

Lectors proclaim the Word of God at Mass, helping the parish community hear and reflect on Scripture.

Ushers & Greeters Ministry

Ushers and greeters provide hospitality, guide seating, and assist with collections, fostering a welcoming spirit at every liturgy.

Altar Servers

Altar Servers assist the priest during Mass, helping with the preparation of the altar, carrying the cross and candles, and participating in the liturgy with reverence and joy. Open to children from 2nd grade through high school, this ministry helps young parishioners grow in faith, learn about the Mass, and serve the Church in a meaningful and visible way.

2. *Faith Formation & Evangelization Committees*

Faith Formation/Religious Education Committee

This committee supports the faith formation programs of our parish. From children to adults seeking to deepen

their faith, the group helps provide resources, plan events, and encourage opportunities for spiritual growth. If you love sharing your faith and helping others grow in theirs, this is a great place to serve.

Baptism Preparation Committee

This committee supports families as they welcome their children into the Catholic Church through the sacrament of Baptism. Members guide parents through the preparation process, provide resources, and offer prayers and support, helping families understand the gift of faith and the responsibilities of raising children in the Church.

Youth Ministry Committee

The Youth Ministry Committee supports our teens and young adults in their journey of faith. By helping plan activities, retreats, and service projects, this group ensures that the younger members of our parish feel valued and engaged in the life of the Church.

Liturgy of the Word for Children

During the 9:30 Mass, the children from grades K through 5 are invited downstairs to the Church Hall to hear the word of God proclaimed in words they can understand. This group seeks individuals who would like help in this ministry. This involves leading the readings and presenting a brief reflection afterwards. Participants are required to be Virtus Trained.

Evangelization & Outreach Committee

This committee helps bring the Good News of Christ to both parishioners and the wider community. Members plan and promote parish missions, faith renewal events, Bible studies, prayer and faith discussion groups, and retreats, fostering spiritual growth and deeper engagement with our Catholic faith. By inviting others to encounter Christ, this team plays a vital role in strengthening the faith life of our parish and reaching out to those seeking a closer relationship with God.

Eucharistic Adoration Committee

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament with coverage Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday in the Chapel and Thursday in Church from 10:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

3. *Pastoral Care & Social Outreach Committees*

Pastoral Care & Homebound Ministry

This ministry brings the love of Christ to those who are sick, elderly, or homebound. Members provide spiritual support, visit parishioners in their homes or hospitals, and bring the sacraments to those unable to attend Mass, ensuring that all members of our parish feel cared for and connected to the Church community.

Food Pantry

The Food Pantry Ministry helps feed those in need within our parish and local community. Members organize and distribute food donations, coordinate volunteers, and ensure that families have access to nutritious meals. This ministry is a tangible way for parishioners to live out Christ's call to serve the poor and vulnerable.

Hospitality & Welcome Committee

The Hospitality and Welcome Committee creates a warm and inviting environment for all who come to St. Michael. Members help organize parish events, including the Coffee Sunday Hour, various social gatherings, assists with the Parish picnic and other gatherings that foster fellowship, friendship, and a sense of belonging within our parish family. The Parish Life Committee helps make St. Michael's feel like a family. If you enjoy meeting people and creating welcoming experiences, this group is for you.

4. Administration & Finance Committees

Parish Finance Council

The Finance Council works closely with our pastor to ensure good stewardship of the parish's resources. Members review budgets, monitor expenses, and help plan for the long-term financial health of the parish. THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Malachi 3:19-20a

The prophet Malachi warned that the time would come when all the evil people would be punished. He then speaks of the arrival of "the sun of justice, with its healing rays," believed by most to mean Jesus.

Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12

Some of the Thessalonians claimed Christ's return was imminent, so they stopped working and asked others for food. Paul describes his willingness to work, so that he would not impose on others. He encourages them to follow his example and earn their own living.

Gospel: Luke 21:5-19

Jesus warns of the persecution all Christians will face because of him, and how some will even be put to death. Yet he says they will not be harmed because "by patient endurance you will save your lives." If Jesus' followers are loyal, they will be resurrected and their suffering will end.

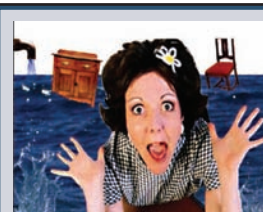
