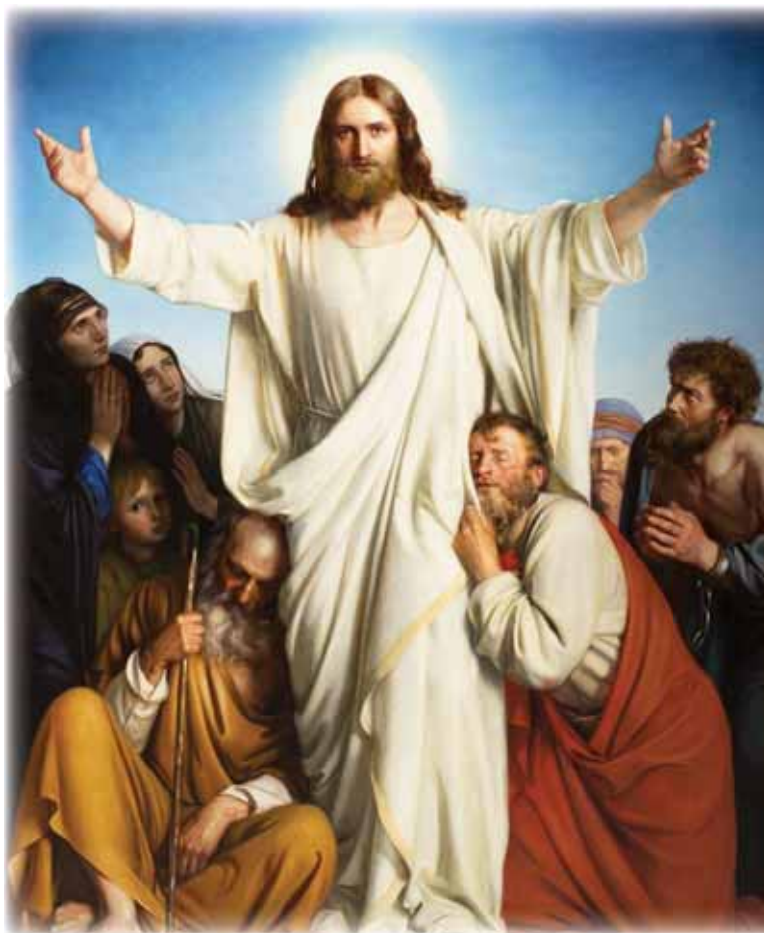

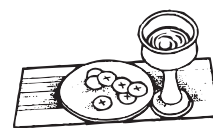

Star High School A Ministry of the Apostles of Jesus

On July 8th / 9th, Fr. Augustine Njuu, A.J. will be a guest in our Parish. Fr. Augustine is a Tanzania-born Roman Catholic Priest. He belongs to the institute of the Apostles of Jesus, a relatively young congregation founded in 1968. The first of its kind to be erected in Africa for the express purpose of training and forming religious missionaries as Priest and Brothers for the evangelizing mission of the Church.

During his visit, he will ask our support for Star Academy Foundation ~ Star High School, a co-ed school for boys and girls in Tanzania. Star High School is Fr. Augustine's lifelong dream, and he opened the school in 2007 with 150 students and currently there are now over 550 students. A second collection will be taken up for Star Academy Foundation ~Star High School on July 8th / 9th.
