- Social Studies 7th 10.7 (3.7 above grade level) 10 scored above HS level
- Social Studies 8th 11.3 (3.3 above grade level) 2 scored above HS level
- Math 5th 5.6 (.6 above grade level)
- Math 6th 6.8 (.8 above grade level)
- Math 7th 10.1 (3.1 above grade level) 6 scored above HS level
- Math 8th 12.0 (4.0 above grade level) 4 scored above HS level
- ELA scores 4 subsets: reading, written expression, writing, vocabulary




Baby Items For Christmas
