

Evangelization is not only proclaiming the Gospel with words but also living it through actions—welcoming the poor, the vulnerable, and the overlooked. In doing so, our lives become a silent, powerful testimony to God's love, inviting others to encounter Christ through our example.

Reflection Question: "Whom am I called to invite or include in my life and in our parish this week?" How can I humbly serve others and make space for those in need this week? Do I feel called to volunteer and help at St. Vincent de Paul?
