

My dearly beloved ones in the Risen Lord,

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is generally termed as the Good Shepherd Sunday in our new Catholic Liturgical calendar. In recent times this day has also become known as Vocation Sunday, a day on which prayers should be said for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. The image of God as the shepherd of his people has a long tradition in the history of Gods people. The image of the shepherd is one which appears several times in the New Testament. It is one that would be immediately understood by the people of the time. In the Gospel of John Jesus calls himself as the Good Shepherd and promises to take care of the sheep entrusted to his care. We have the popular images of Jesus the Good Shepherd carrying a sheep over his shoulders, or we have a smiling Jesus sitting under a tree, with a little lamb on his lap. This image of the shepherd appeals to us because it shows the tenderness of Jesus and his compassion. The sheep followed him, because they recognized his voice, and they trusted him. An image of Jesus as a Good Shepherd is reassuring us that he is always our support on our journey through life.

As we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, let us pray to the Lord that we may be His good sheep, listening attentively to His voice, and follow His example of self-giving love. Let us also pray for all our shepherds, especially our religious and political leaders. May they follow the example of Jesus who was willing to serve and lay down His life for His sheep. We have to narrow a meaning to the word vocation. We tend to limit it to a calling to be a priest or a member of a religious institute. But, in fact, every single one of us has a vocation, as we are being called by God to be spouses, parents, teachers, doctors, civil servants, running a business, or salespersons. Jesus our Shepherd is the Way, Truth and Life. Let us pray for all the vocation and support the vocation. God bless our family and friends.

# The Event Character of the Eucharist

"This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." Luke 22:19 NIV

In the Old Testament, God made covenants with individuals like Abraham and Moses. However, the covenants were then open to all people by a ritual act. whereby each person was made present to the moment of the establishment of the covenant. This is seen in things like circumcision or the Passover. Even to this day at the Seder meal (the Passover meal), the youngest person will ask "Why is this night different from all other nights?" This ritual makes those gathered present to the moment of the Passover. Hence, God commanded that the Passover be done every year (c.f. Exodus 12:14). And the same is true of the Eucharist. We too partake in a ritual act. We too are made present to the establishment of the New Covenant at the Last Supper. We too do this because of a divine command: "do this in remembrance of me." The Eucharist is indeed the New and Eternal Covenant.

When you imagine the Last Supper, what does it look like? Which apostle would you most like to speak with?


