Eucharistic Prayer #9-The Epiclesis

"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Thy faithful and kindle in them the fire of Thy love." Excerpt of the Prayer Veni Sancte Spiritus

The Epiclesis is the term for the invocation of the Holy Spirit to sanctify that which is offered to God. The First Epiclesis over the bread and wine is accompanied by the priest extending his hands over them. This is meant to be a symbol of the Holy Spirit's descent upon the gifts we have brought to the altar, that they may be changed into the body of Christ. However, after the Consecration, there is another Epiclesis as the priest invokes the Holy Spirit to sanctify those who are gathered together around the Altar, so that we who receive the Body of Christ may become the body of Christ.
