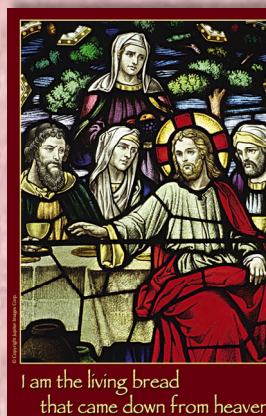

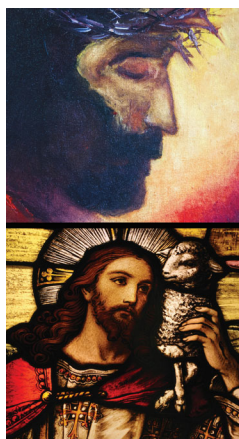

Deacon Joe and his wife, Karen, both have a deeply-rooted love of and commitment to social justice outreach to the poor and marginalized. They and their family were the "engine" that started our annual trips to Appalachia, forming our first social justice ministry, Operation Appalachia. They also spearheaded relief trips to New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina. In addition, Deacon Joe has visited the poor in Haiti, where our parish sponsored the building of Notre Dame Village after devastating hurricanes hit the island.

We join in congratulations and a profound sense of thanksgiving for these two special deacons and their wives. We love and are grateful for your presence and for all you are contributing to our journey of parish renewal!

We celebrated the great feast of Pentecost, the birthday of our Church, in a host of memorable ways. It was nametag weekend, so everyone coming through our doors was greeted by a parish minister and given a nametag. At each Mass, Father Paddy preached a vision homily on the redemptive power of love, using the symbols of wind and fire as they were experienced by the apostles when the Holy Spirit came upon them in the Upper Room.



Fr. Paddy invited up to the altar anyone who had experienced a transformation of faith in the past 12 months, and also those who seek a similar transformation during the coming year. The many parishioners who came forward for a blessing gave powerful witness to the work of the Spirit in the renewal of our parish. We estimate that all told, approximately 250-300 parishioners were willing to witness to a journey of deeper faith.

We prayed for their continuing journey of growth in the faith.

## *How has Eucharistic Adoration affected your life?*

*"After my hour I came away refreshed, recharged, renewed. I need that constantly, since I'm the mother of three teenagers."*

"When someone needs a sub for his or her hour and I am able to go, it feels like Jesus is calling me to be with Him and pray. There is always a need to pray for something or someone. Adoration is such a blessing from God for all of us."

"It's an awesome experience to meet Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament - words cannot explain it."

"When I said "YES" to be an adorer at our Adoration Chapel it grew to be the most wonderful, positive communication with Jesus that I have ever had. Adoration is a whole new experience of being aware of the Real Presence of Jesus right here with us. I leave the Chapel feeling as if time stood still while I was there, and I have had a chance to get a better grip on my life."

"Hours spent with my Lord are refreshing to my soul. The more hectic life becomes, the more I need that time of solitude that adoration provides."

"I drop in on my way to work and offer my day to Jesus."

"I'm a senior citizen. Wish I knew about this years ago - but I'm making up for lost time."

"Since I came to adoration, my prayer, my lifestyle, my attitudes, have changed."

"Going to the chapel has moved my spirit to new heights. In accepting what Jesus is doing in my life, I realize He never fails and what He does in my life is all for a good purpose."



"My experience during adoration hour is one of personal peace. I go to talk and listen to God, and when I am done, I know I am loved and accepted. I can go back in the world with more confidence."

"A friend invited me to come to the Adoration Chapel and pray. My life was busy and I had no interest praying in the chapel but I did go. As I prayed, words cannot describe the love and peace that I felt...He touched me...and now going to the chapel is an important part of my life."

"One good thing that has happened to me since I started Adoration is my youngest child and his family have returned to the Church. I've

been praying for the conversion of all my children for many years."

"The Adoration Chapel represents love, God's love for me. I know I must have an open heart to hear this call. The sixty minutes I am there with Our Lord has made me aware of what my priority is; homeward bound to heaven."

"Personally, I think we need to educate the parishioners about the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. Then if the people understand why Jesus is here for them, more would come to be with Him. Adoration is a place we come together for God."
