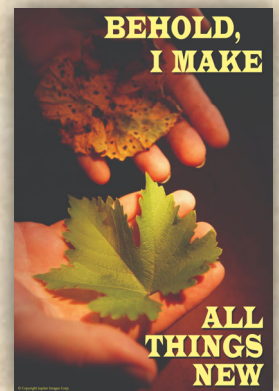

But call Paul the "energizing evangelist," transforming deadly cruelty into life-giving zeal. But Revelation's present assurance, "Behold, God's dwelling is with the human race," should challenge us to become "missionaries of mercy." Because Pope Francis declared that the Church's credibility is completely dependent on our showing unconditional mercy. Mercy, said Francis, makes the Church, the world, and everyone young again, reawakened to life's noblest virtues. Fittingly, in today's Gospel Jesus reinforces that theme: "This is how all will know you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

A MORE IN-DEPTH LOOK AT THE HOSPITALITY CONVOCATION

As previously shared, on April 27 nearly 80 of our faithful – including leaders, ministers, those perhaps considering ministry, and also our two priests – attended our first-ever HOSPITALITY CONVOCATION. The morning's theme, *"Let love be genuine...practice hospitality"* (Rom 12:9, 12), was beautifully fleshed out by gifted facilitator and parishioner, Linda Baratte, who took participants on a deep dive into the spiritual virtue of radical hospitality, especially as we see it in the earthly ministry of Jesus.

Alternating between Linda's presenting powerful examples of hospitality from scripture and other sources, with interactive table-sharing, Linda surfaced in a meaningful way how radical hospitality must be at the foundation of our parish renewal. Based on a survey that was launched immediately following the Convocation, the overwhelming majority of attendees felt inspired and re-energized to take our already welcoming parish to a new and deeper level of opening our doors to everyone, especially those in need and on the margins. Heartfelt thanks to our facilitator for leading us on this insightful, prayerful journey!

"Linda offered insights that were a first for me, especially the virtue of hospitality as it relates to Jesus"



"I think it made me realize that hospitality and welcoming is more than a smile and good morning to those entering church for Mass."

"Sharing of ideas in pushing gently and finding room gave me much hope that we will expand our circle in following Jesus together. Always trying to incorporate these ideas in my ministry."

"Radical" hospitality was discussed at our table, and sometimes the simplest gesture that may feel "radical" to the giver means everything to the receiver."

"Continue these group sessions, because when people come together and they put their minds together, they come up with awesome ideas."

"We need to speak regularly to the theme and need for hospitality -- to our leaders, ministers and to the congregation at large. We need to be



watchful of examples of radical hospitality and celebrate publicly this behavior that is so meaningful and critical to our mission!"

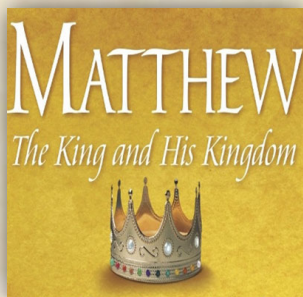

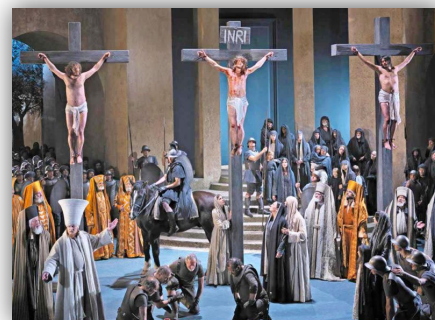

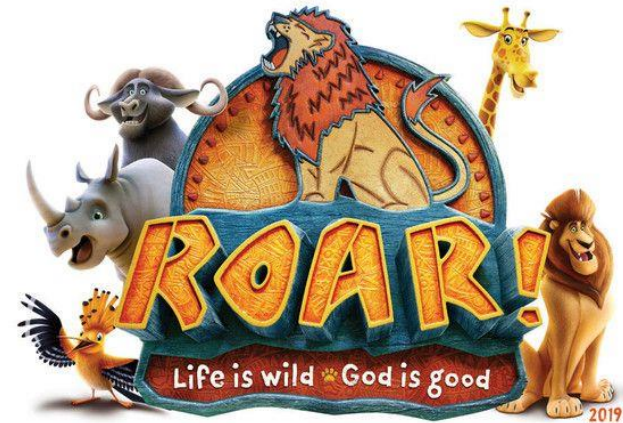
