

"I learned about a couple of 'pivotal players' that I hadn't known much about. They are inspiring Christians, and their lives are models for my own faith journey."


"Love the convenience of a virtual group. I also loved connecting with other Catholic people and getting to know them on a deeper level. It was enjoyable studying the material together."




