

A Call to Walk Like Jesus

Back in August of 2019, a humble servant of Jesus and also of our parish, nearly lost his life as a result of a viral infection that viciously attacked his already compromised immune system. In full recognition of this critical time in his life, he asked the Lord to give him a higher purpose should the Lord choose **not** to call him to eternal life at that point. As our friend and servant miraculously recovered, the call from above became clear: a ministry that would serve lonely hearts on the margins of life. Our friend and servant: Dick White. The ministry: The Feet of Christ. Dick's vision for this ministry follows:



"We are a group who seek to support those who live alone and would welcome a visit for conversation, a game of cards, a book or bible reading, or perhaps a cup of tea, and just contact with another saint on our journey here in the Earthly Kingdom. Being "alone" is not undesirable. It offers us the opportunity to reflect, even to meditate on the big (and little) thing of life. Being "lonely" on the other hand is not desirable and that is what The Feet of Christ seeks to address."



"One feature of the visitation we plan to include is the "Walk." This consists of the minister parking some distance (no marathons please) from the target home/location, say, one block. The minister would then proceed to the location in a non-hurried walk much as Christ proceeded to and through the villages of Judea and Samaria. After a time, others in the neighborhood would inquire as to what's going on, and this would provide the opportunity to explain the notion of The Feet of Christ. This would not be a preaching moment, but simply an acknowledgment of following His example..."

It wasn't God's plan for Dick to bring this ministry to fruition. Sadly, after succumbing to a long struggle with multiple myeloma, Dick passed away last Wednesday evening. Yet, for the many who knew Dick personally and through his extended service here at Notre Dame and beyond, we are reminded that much as Dick did, we are called to walk in the Feet of Christ, not just as members of a ministry but in all we do in our daily living.

"Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him."

Let us pray for the peace and comfort of Dick's wife Debbie and their loved ones.
