# Food Rescue: "We couldn't do this without you!"

In the June 28th Parish Update, we asked for a few volunteers to help with the bagging of bread, re-wrapping of sandwiches, and pick-up of bagels.



Before the week was over we had the volunteers needed to continue supporting this "leg" of our ministry.

On Friday, July 2nd we put out a call via Facebook/SignUp Genius for various items needed for the assembly of "Blessing Bags" to be distributed this week by Hope One to those in need in our local area.



By Sunday evening, July 4th, the entire list of items needed had been spoken for!

From the start of COVID shutdown through the present, countless parishioners have been faithfully and regularly dropping off food donations in the van at 16 Ridgedale Ave., or through the Food & Clothing Collection events we've held this past year.



While we may be emerging from COVID, there are still many people without jobs or means to provide for themselves and their families. The time and faithful service of those who are part of the Food Rescue Ministry and the continuing generosity of this parish community are at the heart of this ministry's mission and response to those in need.

### Alpha at ND featured in The Beacon!

The Alpha experience here at Notre Dame was recently featured in the diocesan newspaper, The Beacon. The article, "Alpha becomes powerful tool for Evangelization at Notre Dame Parish," offered insights into what the journey is all about, its history to-date at Notre Dame, and why it has become such a vital conduit for our renewal and mission of bringing others into deeper relationship with Christ and the Church.

### **Alpha:** Powerful tool for Evangelization

Renovation, a ministry that accompanies parishes seeking renewal, Notre Dame Parish was introduced to the Alpha experi-ence, which has become one of its most powerful evangelization tools. "With prayerful reliance on the Holy Spirit, Alpha has helped strengthen the parish's invita-tional culture, its outreach to the spiritually disconnected, and its ability to cultivate new leaders. The Alpha model has helped Notre Dame build community and proclaim the kerygma in a friendly, nonjudgmental environment that has wide appeal, includ-ing to young adults," said Cristina Folan, Notre Dame's director of communications and evangelization

Alpha is an 11-week series of weekly sessions, each one featuring a meal, video, and small group discussion. The parish has witnessed several lives changed by the Alpha experience, some in radical ways. For example, in the fall of 2019, a former Catholic turned atheist, having avoided go-ing to church for decades, agreed to take Alpha as a result of his wife's encouragement. He had a transformational experi-ence that produced a profound reconnec-

After four fruitful series at the parish, and just as the fifth Alpha series had gotten underway, the pandemic struck and the church had to be closed. The celebration of Masses and small faith-sharing groups transitioned successfully from in-person to a vir-tual format, but there were concerns about whether a journey like Alpha could be effective in a remote enviro

Surprisingly, the former atheist who had experienced a transformation of heart felt passionate that the virtual approach would work and offered to lead the next journey online. Joined by a co-leader and a supporting team, the first virtual Alpha series was launched in June 2020.

Over the next 12 months of the pan-demic, three 11-week Alpha courses were run online. More than 110 participants took the journey, joining from at least nine different states, as well as from Mexico and Argentina. The unintended blessing of the pandemic was that through virtual Alpha, Notre Dame was indeed able to "go out and make disciples of all nations." Father O'Donovan, who experienced

Alpha in one of the early in-person series, offered these insights about the program: "Alpha is an evangelizing tool that introduc-es people to a transforming relationship with Jesus Christ. Notre Dame's Alpha web page is filled with personal testimonies, both written and filmed, from many who have experienced Alpha at Notre Dame. "One of the greatest fruits of recent offerings is that three par-ticipants from the Diocese, including two pastors, have decided to bring Alpha to their own parishes. Through the grace of the Holy Spirit impacting participants in Alpha, the work of the Great Commission will continue to flourish throughout the Diocese of Paterson," said Folan.
