## Finance Ministry "Q & A"

Last Monday, Finance Ministry Leaders Mike Critchley and Will Fernandez, along with other Finance ministry representatives, offered parishioners an opportunity to ask questions regarding the recently published **Parish Finance Report for the fiscal year ending June 30,** 2021.



The gathering opened with prayer and introductions and followed with an overview of the Finance ministry's purpose, mission, and goals. Mike and Will then offered an in-depth review of the Operating Income and Expenses and current assets for our parish. The Q & A led to a discussion regarding recent trends in both offertory income and expenditures, current and future needs, and financial concerns for our faith community moving forward.

"I attended the Finance Ministry meeting purely out of curiosity for the financial health and well-being of Notre Dame. Having a background in finance and business management, I wondered how much of a hit our parish took because of COVID and reduced attendance, and the added expenses caused by the fire last year. I was pleasantly surprised when our efficient financial team laid out the facts, including that the parish was granted a substantial "forgiveness loan," helping to defray losses. However, we are not out of the woods. The parish needs to continue managing costs, and we need to encourage more folks to give. Online giving saves money by eliminating envelopes. And using electronic funds transfer (from checking or savings account) saves credit card fees. Let's make sure...no

matter how small your donation...that we continue to support the mission of Notre Dame of Mt. Carmel!" Judy Foster


