



An Experience in Adoration

"The time you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the best time that you will spend on earth. Each moment that you spend with Jesus will deepen your union with Him and make your soul everlastingly more glorious and beautiful in heaven, and will help bring about everlasting peace on earth." - St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta

Pope Francis launched a yearlong celebration of the Year of the Eucharist in 2022 to encourage the faithful to develop a greater love and appreciation of the Eucharist. Unfortunately, most self-described Catholics don't believe in this core teaching. Nearly seven in ten Catholics (69%) say they believe that during Catholic Mass, the bread and wine used in Communion "are symbols of the body and blood of Jesus Christ."

Therefore, this past Tuesday & Wednesday, February 1 & 2, the Middle School EDGE Faith Formation sessions focused on this vital tenet of the faith, with a particular emphasis on the meaning of the True Presence. The evenings ended in the Chapel, with time spent in Jesus' presence in Eucharistic Adoration.

Following the exposition of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament by Fr. Paddy and Fr. Alex and the blessing with incense, the participants were led through a brief period of guided prayer especially geared for children, along with music. They were invited to think of a personal prayer intention. Everyone received a small prayer card that could be addressed and given to the special person for whom they prayed. The children were then invited to depart the chapel in silence to preserve the feeling of peace they received from this special time with Jesus.


