Diocesan Guidelines for baptizing a child:

- If the PARENTS are not members of the Cathedral, a letter from the parish in which the parents reside or are registered must be presented, giving permission for the child to be baptized at Saint Mary Cathedral. This must be done **prior** to registration for Baptism.
- Copy of the state birth certificate or hospital birth certificate for the child being baptized.
- Single godparents must be **practicing Catholics living according to the norms of the Church**.
- Married couples serving as godparents must be married by the Catholic Church.
- Parents and godparents must attend a Baptismal Preparation class **prior** to the Baptism. If the class is taken in another parish, proof of attendance must be presented.
- Godparents must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation.
- All Baptism documents must be received in the office **before** a Baptism date can be set.

- Si los PADRES no son miembros de la Catedral, necesitaran presentar una carta de la Parroquia a la que pertenezcan, ya sea por residencia o donde se encuentren registrados, dando permiso para bautizar al bebe aquí en la Catedral. Esto se requiere **antes de** registrarse para bautizar.
- Copia del acta de nacimiento del Estado del niño(a)
- Padrinos/Madrinas solteros(as) deben ser Católicos **practicantes viviendo según las normas de la Iglesia**.
- Todos los padrinos casados deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica. Se deberá presentar una copia del acta de matrimonio por la Iglesia.
- Padres y Padrinos, deberán atender la clase de Bautismo **antes de** bautizar. Si la toman en otra parroquia, se requiere presenten comprobante de asistencia.
- Padrinos tienen que haber recibido todos los Sacramentos de iniciación: Bautizo, 1ª Comunión y Confirmación.
- **Antes de** que la fecha del Bautismo se pueda fijar, la oficina necesitará obtener el paquete completo satisfaciendo todos los requisitos.
