

From the Rector—*Discipleship and Desire*

I knew in 6th grade that I really wanted to excel at the piano. I had been working with Mrs. Buss for several years, and as she noted my progress one day she said, "I think it's time you interviewed for a new teacher. I recommend we set up a meeting with Veri & Jamanis. They are performing artists, a husband and wife piano duo, who live here in Lancaster, and I think one of them might be very good for you." So, I went and played for both Ms. Veri and Mr. Jamanis. We all agreed it best that I work with Ms. Veri. I was always a little nervous going to piano lessons because Veri & Jamanis played in the great halls in New York City and around the country. They were featured on the Merv Griffin show, were also making recordings, and toured the country every giving concerts. I had a deep desire to become a musician like them, to emulate them, to learn everything I could from them. Indeed Ms. Veri shaped my playing for the next six years and helped prepare for my entry into the Juilliard School.

I can also recall the ardent curiosity and desire that drove my journey into the Catholic Church: What is the role of Mary? What does Baptism mean for a Catholic? What is the role of faith and works? What prominence do Catholics assign the Holy Bible? I possessed a deep desire for more: more information, more contact with, more encounter. To be a disciple of Jesus is to be a student, one who remains in relationship with the Master Teacher. And desire is what drives the disciple to remain at Jesus' side. Many gathered around Jesus to sit on the mount and listen as he taught them about the kingdom of God. Desire drives our willingness to commit to prayer time each day; shapes how we teach and raise our families; and ultimately sets the course for eternity. Desire, when practiced in prayer and lived out through the sacraments, becomes true devotion. We must return often -- daily, indeed -- to refresh and renew our encounter with the living Word, and in the secret places of prayer we allow his love to resonate in our hearts. How ardent is your desire?



Yo sabía que en 6º grado que quería sobresalir en el piano. Había estado trabajando con la Sra. Buss desde hace varios años, y como señalé mi progreso un día dijo, "Pienso que es tiempo de entrevistar un nuevo profesor. Te recomiendo que organices una reunión con Veri y Jamanis. Son artistas, un esposo y esposa piano dúo, que viven aquí en Lancaster, y creo que uno de ellos podría ser muy bueno para ti." Así que, fui y jugué para la Sra. Veri y el Sr. Jamanis. Todos estuvimos de acuerdo que lo mejor será que trabajaba con la Sra. Veri. Siempre estaba un poco nervioso ir a clases de piano porque Veri y Jamanis habían jugado en las grandes salas en Nueva York y en todo el país. Se presentaron en el show de Merv Griffin, estaban haciendo grabaciones y recorrían por el país dando conciertos. Tenía un profundo deseo de imitarlos, de aprender todo que lo posible de ellos. La Sra. Veri me formó los próximos seis años y me ayudó prepararme para la entrada en la escuela de Juilliard.

También puedo recordar la ardiente curiosidad y deseo que me atrajo a la iglesia católica: ¿Cuál es el papel de María? ¿Qué significa el bautismo para un católico? ¿Cuál es el papel de la fe y las obras? ¿Qué protagonismo asignar los católicos a la Santa Biblia? Poseyó un deseo profundo para más información: más información, más contacto, más encuentro. Para ser un discípulo de Jesús debe ser un estudiante, debe seguir siendo en relación con el maestro de maestros. Y el deseo es lo que da ánimo al discípulo a permanecer al lado de Jesús. Muchos se reunieron alrededor de Jesús para sentarse en el Monte y escuchar cómo les enseñaba sobre el Reino de Dios. Deseo mueve nuestra voluntad a cometer a la hora de oración cada día; forma cómo enseñamos y criamos a nuestras familias; y esencialmente, fija el curso para la eternidad. El deseo, cuando se practica en oración y se vive a través de los sacramentos, se convierte en verdadera devoción. Tenemos que volver diariamente, a reanimar y renovar nuestro encuentro con la Palabra viva y en los lugares secretos de oración, permitir que su amor resuene en nuestros corazones. ¿Cuánto arde su deseo?

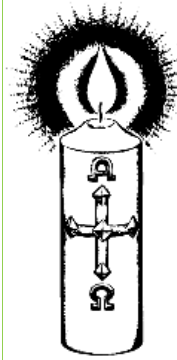

Diocesan Guidelines for baptizing a child:

- If the PARENTS are not members of the Cathedral, a letter from the parish in which the parents reside or are registered must be presented, giving permission for the child to be baptized at Saint Mary Cathedral. This must be done **prior** to registration for Baptism.
- Copy of the state birth certificate or hospital birth certificate for the child being baptized.
- Single godparents must be **practicing Catholics living according to the norms of the Church**.
- Married couples serving as godparents must be married by the Catholic Church.
- Parents and godparents must attend a Baptismal Preparation class **prior** to the Baptism. If the class is taken in another parish, proof of attendance must be presented.
- Godparents must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation.
- All Baptism documents must be received in the office **before** a Baptism date can be set.

Requisitos de la Diócesis para bautizar a un bebe:

- Si los PADRES no son miembros de la Catedral, necesitaran presentar una carta de la Parroquia a la que pertenezcan, ya sea por residencia o donde se encuentren registrados, dando permiso para bautizar al bebe aquí en la Catedral. Esto se requiere **antes** de registrarse para bautizar.
- Copia del acta de nacimiento del Estado del niño(a)
- Padrinos/Madrinas solteros(as) deben ser Católicos **practicantes viviendo según las normas de la Iglesia**.
- Todos los padrinos casados deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica. Se deberá presentar una copia del acta de matrimonio por la Iglesia.
- Padres y Padrinos, deberán atender la clase de Bautismo **antes** de bautizar. Si la toman en otra parroquia, se requiere presenten comprobante de asistencia.
- Padrinos tienen que haber recibido todos los Sacramentos de iniciación: Bautizo, 1ª Comunión y Confirmación.
- **Antes** de que la fecha del Bautismo se pueda fijar, la oficina necesitará obtener el paquete completo satisfaciendo todos los requisitos.

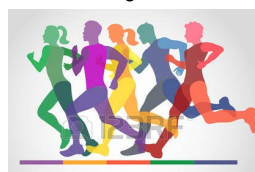
