Rector's Corner

During my first year of priesthood, I was relaying a frustrating staff situation to my pastor, Fr. Robert Becker. He responded with, "I like to presume the good." When tasked with coming up with my Core Values for Saint Mary Cathedral, Presume the Good became my first Core Value:

Presume the Good

This value models divine charity, which seeks first the will and love of God over one's own preferences. It manifests in a willingness to think the best of the other, and an unwillingness to get into the business of judging others' motives. This value fosters an interior attitude of peace and seeks first to understand rather than to be understood.

"If I give away everything I own, and if I hand my body over so that I may boast but do not have love, I gain nothing.

Love is patient, love is kind. It is not jealous, love is not pompous, it is not inflated, it is not rude, it does not seek its own interests, it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrongdoing but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things" (I Cor. 13:3-7).

As I prepare to leave Saint Mary Cathedral, I exhort each one of us to guard the peace of Christ which passes all understanding and to continue cheering one another along on the roadway to heaven, the pathway of Saints In Training! Christ teaches us about Himself and forms us for the kingdom as we presume the good in community.

Thank you for sharing the joy of your faith with me these past three years! You will be missed! And you are treasured for the many ways you have formed me as a spiritual father and helped us to grow together in holiness.

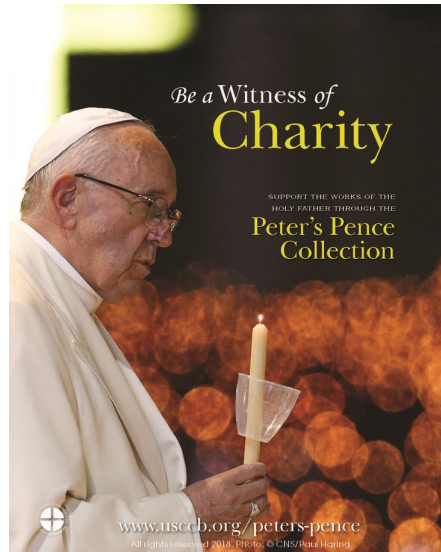

El amor es paciente, el amor es amable. No es celoso, el amor no aparenta, ni se engrandece, no se deja llevar por la ira, no busca sus propios intereses, no anda de mal humor, no se queja de las lesiones, no se regocija por las malas acciones, sino que se regocija con la verdad. Lleva todas las cosas, cree todas las cosas, espera todas las cosas, soporta todas las cosas" (I Cor. 13: 3-7).

Mientras me preparo para dejar la Catedral de Santa María, les invito a cada uno de ustedes a guardar la paz de Cristo, que pasa todo el entendimiento y a continuar nuestro camino al cielo, ¡el camino de los Santos en práctica! 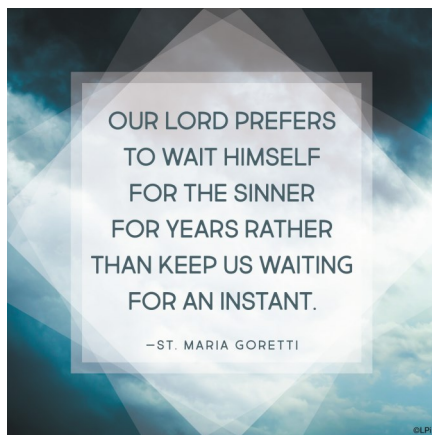
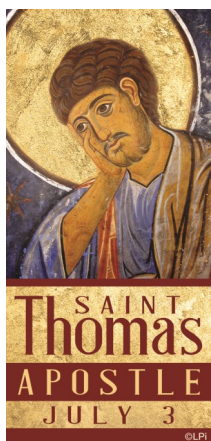
Everyday Stewardship

I personally was baptized as an infant, grew up in the Church, and never experienced a time when I was fully the prodigal son. I have sinned quite often throughout my years, but I never drifted so far away where I needed that moment of truth to help me see the light.

However, that does not diminish the fact that I have been made new in Christ and I need to live in a way that leaves the old me behind. If you are like me, you must admit there are times when that former self comes into view. There are times when we fall into our sin to the point where no one would believe we were baptized disciples of Jesus. Thank God there is forgiveness through the sacraments. When we fall, we can always recover and be made new again.

So maybe it is not true that people like me don't have a profound conversion story. Maybe the truth is we simply have MANY conversion stories. As we continually strive to pick up our crosses and follow Him, we fall away and need to come back to Him. Each time, we have a new story. Each time, God's love and healing are profound. Each time, we have something new to tell.
